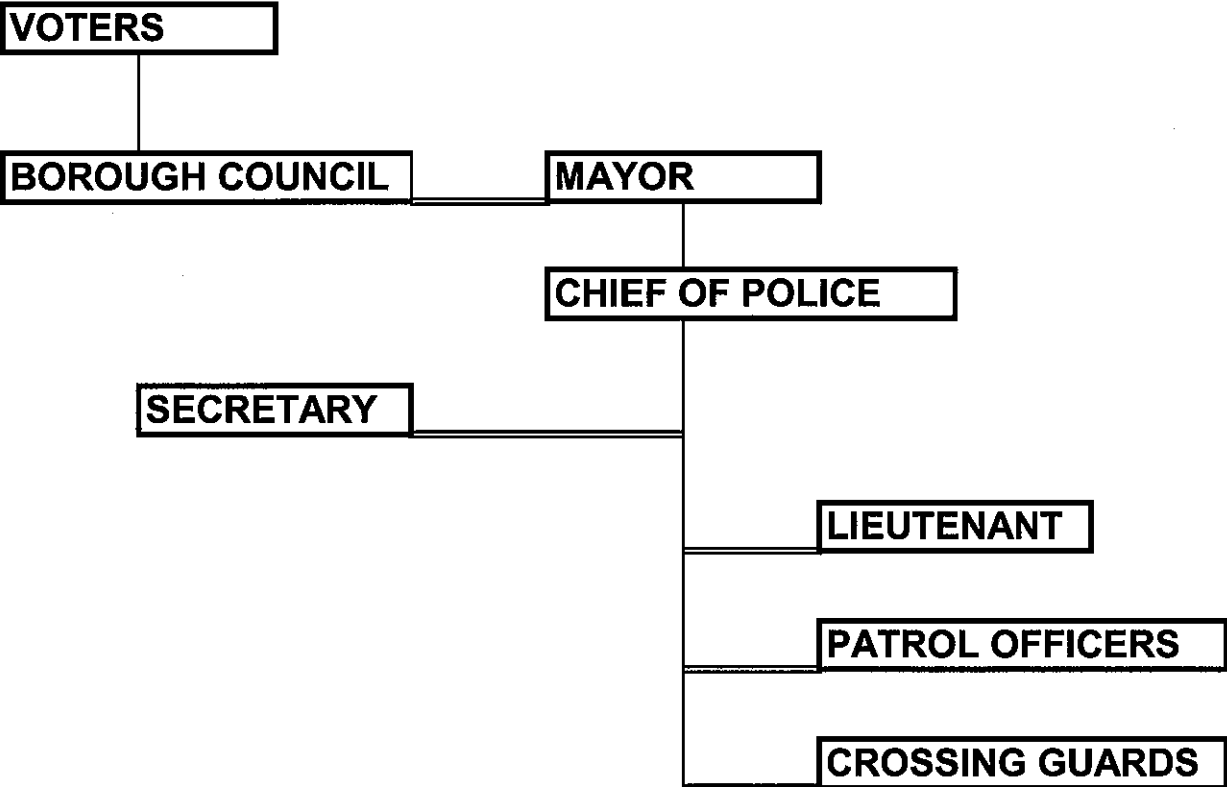

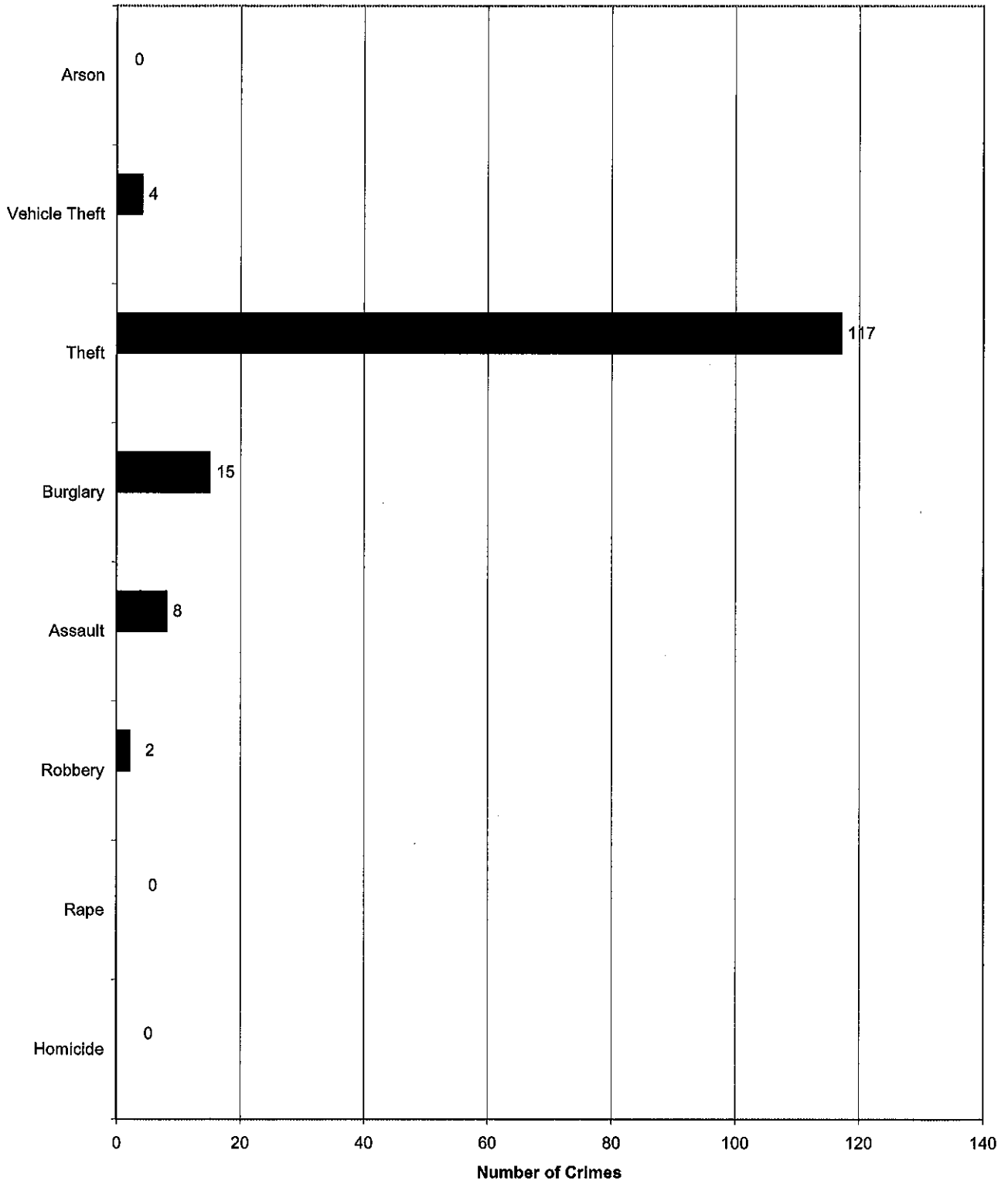

DEFINITIONS

For the purpose of providing a better understanding of the following charts representing the activities of the Police Department, the following definitions are provided:

- PART I OFFENSES** : Criminal Homicide, Forcible Rape, Robbery, Aggravated Assault, Burglary, Larceny-Theft, Motor Vehicle Theft and Arson.
- PART II OFFENSES** : Other Assaults, Forgery and Counterfeiting, Fraud, Embezzlement, Stolen Property (Buying, Receiving, Possessing), Vandalism, Weapons (Carrying, Possessing, etc.), Prostitution and Commercialized Vice, Sex Offenses, Drug Abuse Violations, Gambling, Offenses Against the Family and Children, Driving Under the Influence, Liquor Laws, Public Drunkenness, Disorderly Conduct, and All Other Criminal Offenses.
- POLICE SERVICES** : Represents those activities other than crime, which require investigation or Police Assistance. Police services are generally considered to consist of the following: Fire Calls, Service to Another Agency, Public Service (those calls that render a service, i.e. open doors/windows, lockouts, Message Delivery, etc.), False Alarms, Lost -Found Property, Suspicious Persons, Suspicious Vehicles, Domestic Disputes, Neighborhood Disturbances, Animal Complaints, Mental Cases, Suicides and Attempted Suicides, Suspicious Deaths, Traffic related (funeral escorts, parades, etc.), Surveillance, and other investigations of a non-criminal nature.
- TRAFFIC ACCIDENT INVESTIGATION** : The complete investigation of all motor vehicle accidents which occur within the Borough Limits of Palmyra.

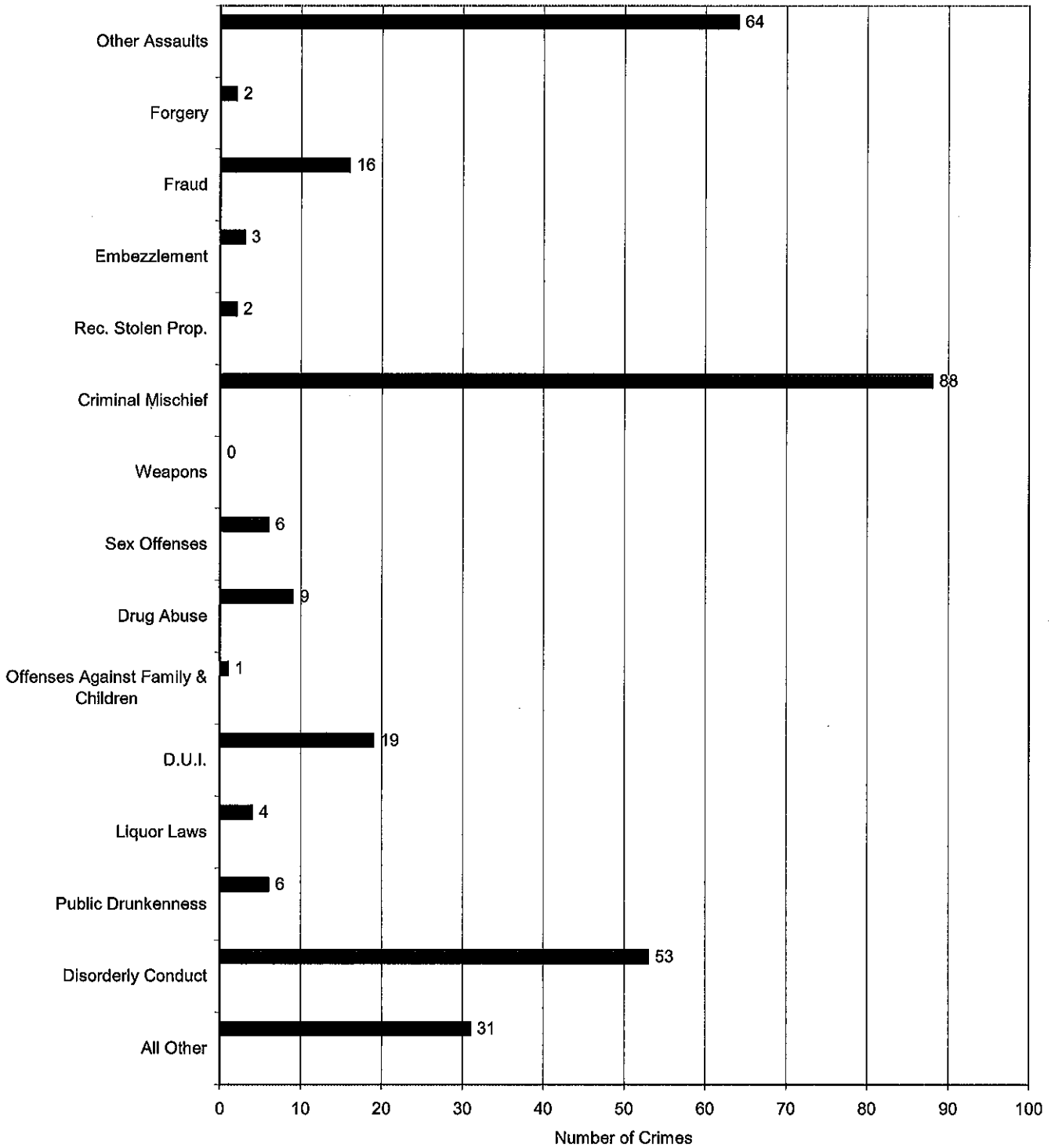

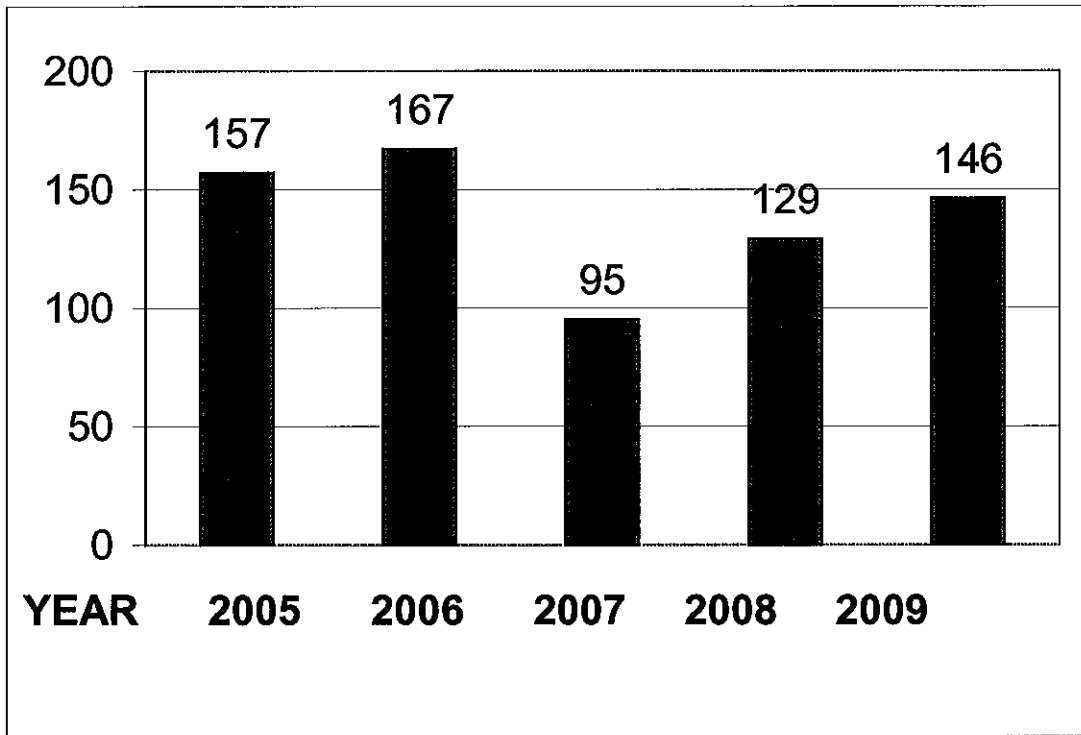

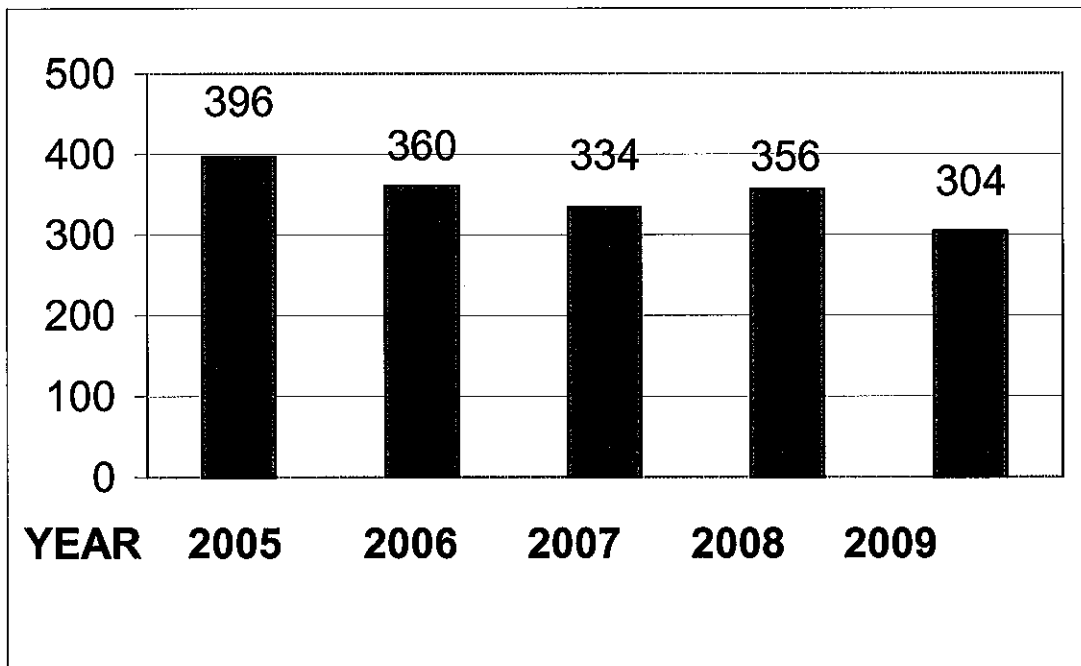

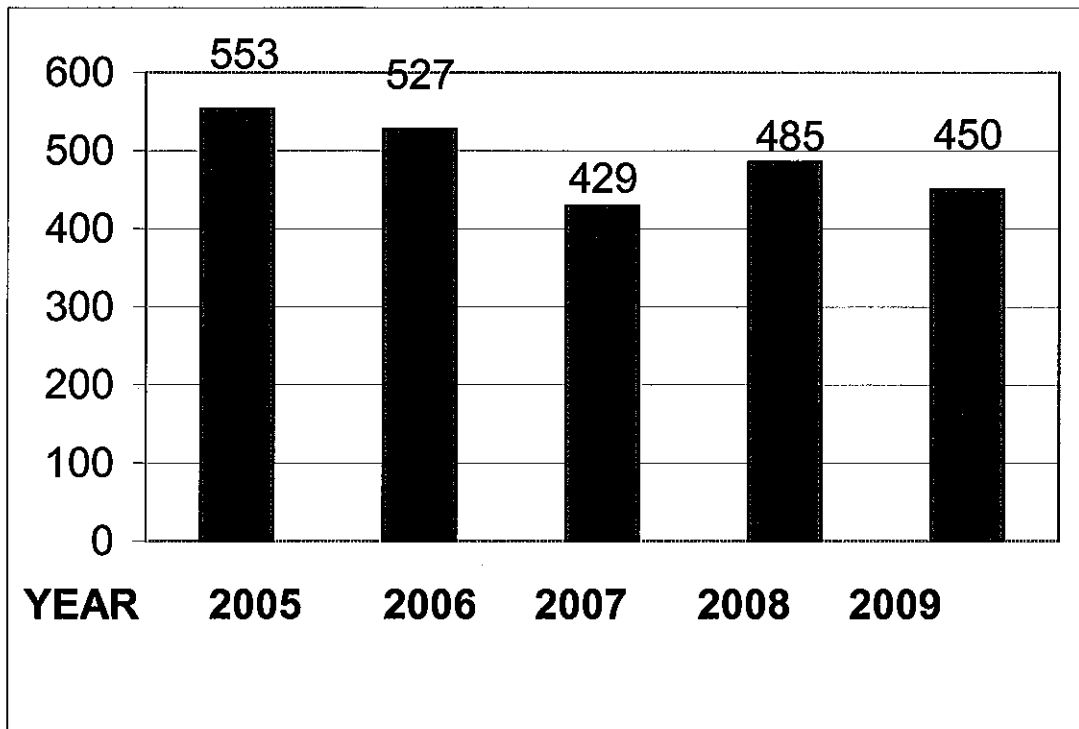
PART I CRIMES (2005 - 2009)



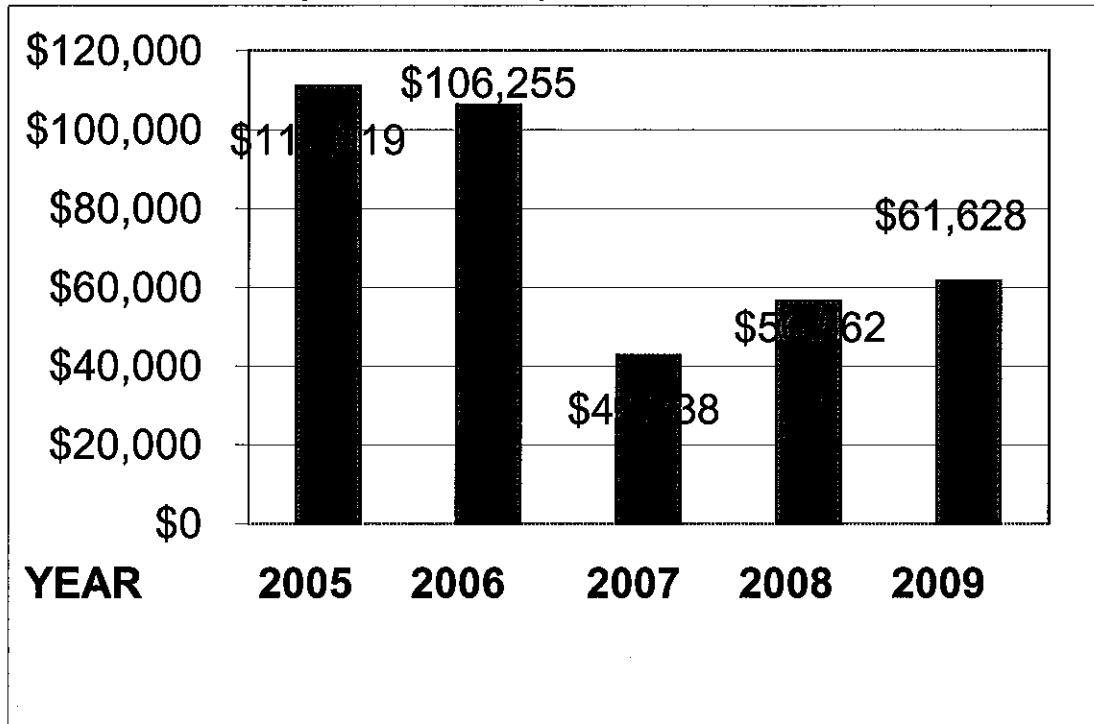
PART II CRIMES (2005 - 2009)



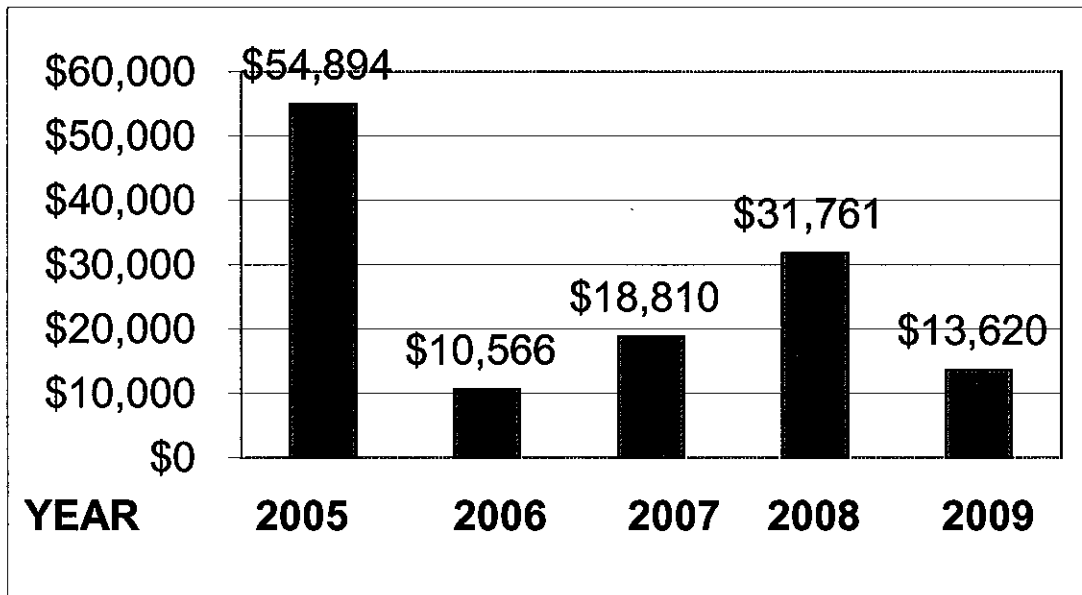
TOTAL CRIMES (2005 - 2009)



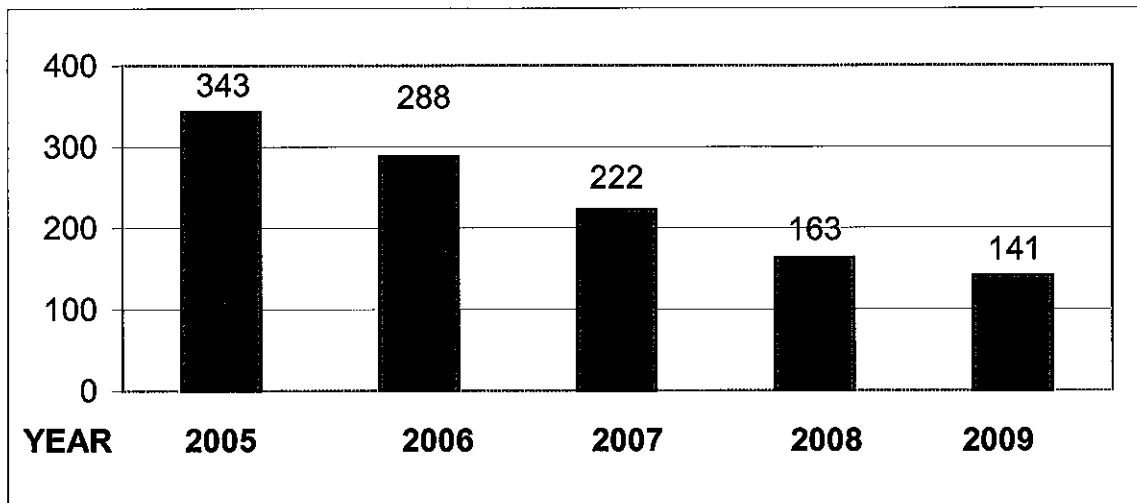
VALUE OF PROPERTY STOLEN (2005 - 2009)



VALUE OF PROPERTY RECOVERED (2005 - 2009)

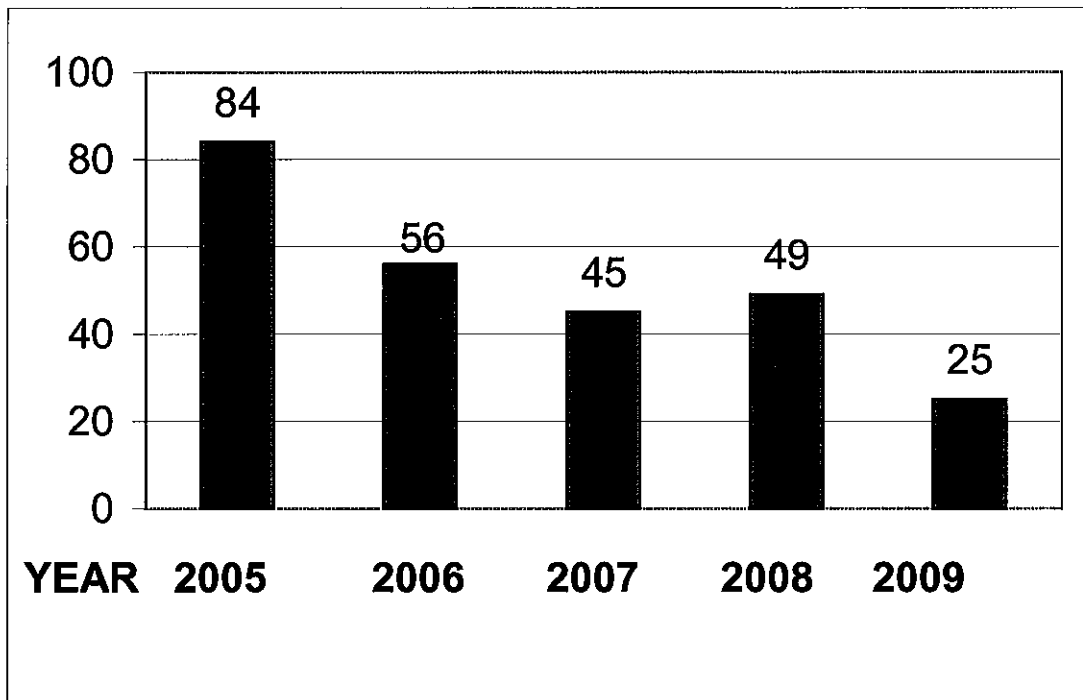

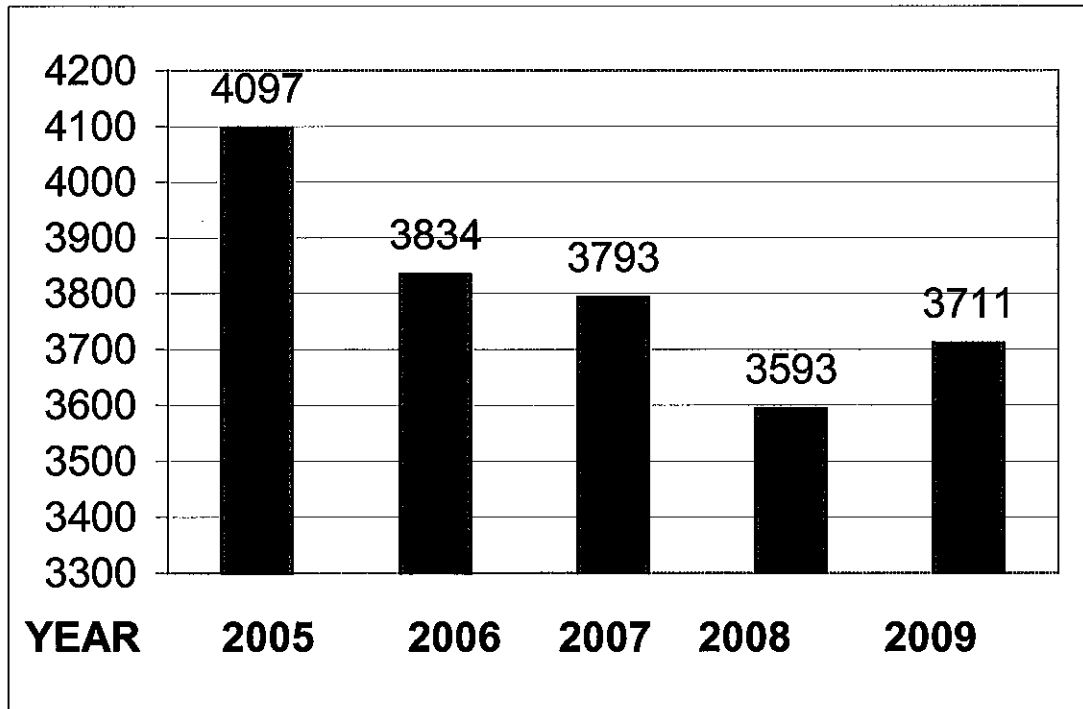
WRITTEN WARNINGS (2005 - 2009)

CALLS RECEIVED (2005 - 2009)



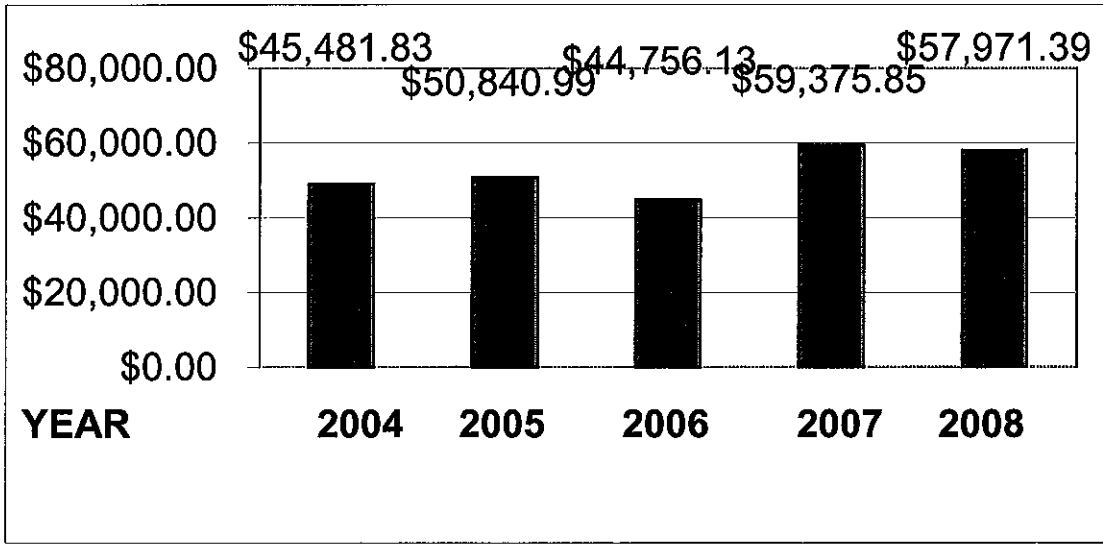

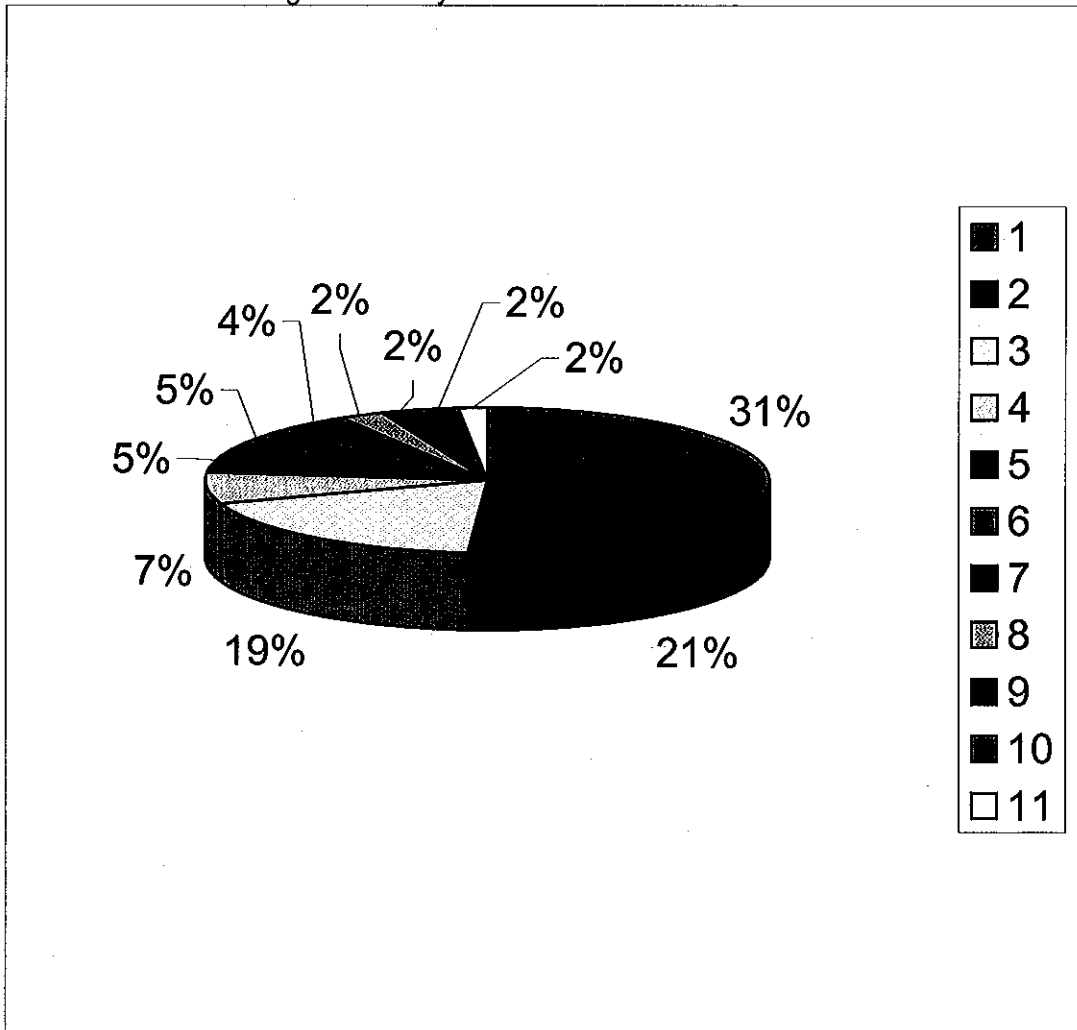


ACCIDENT INJURIES (2005 - 2009)



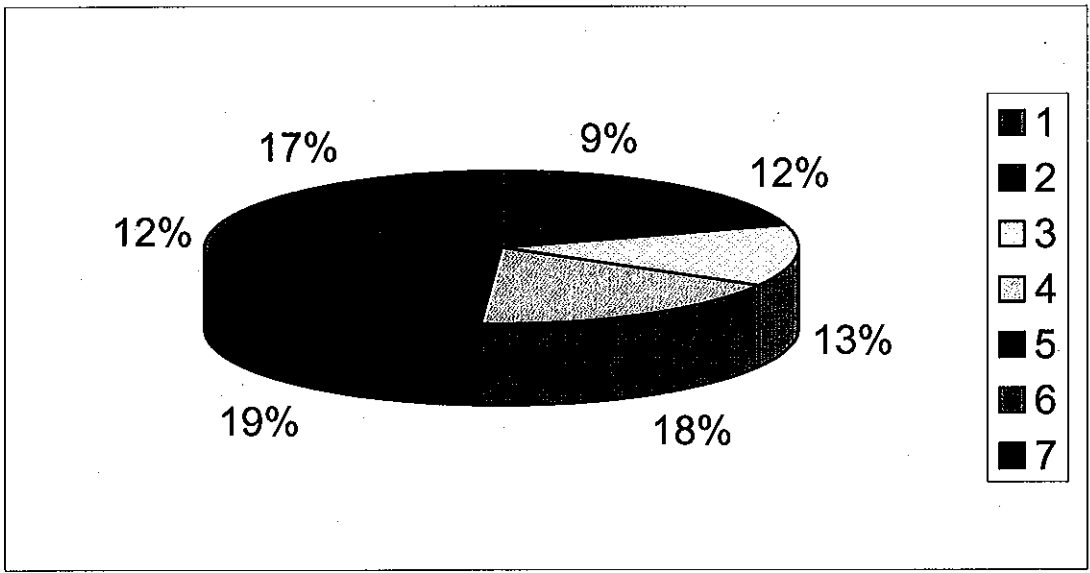

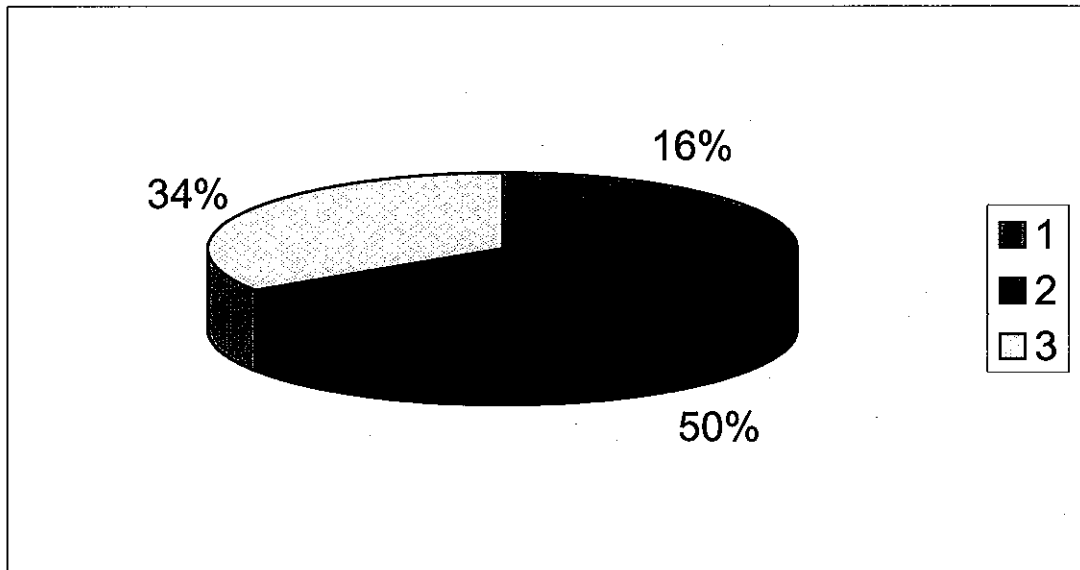

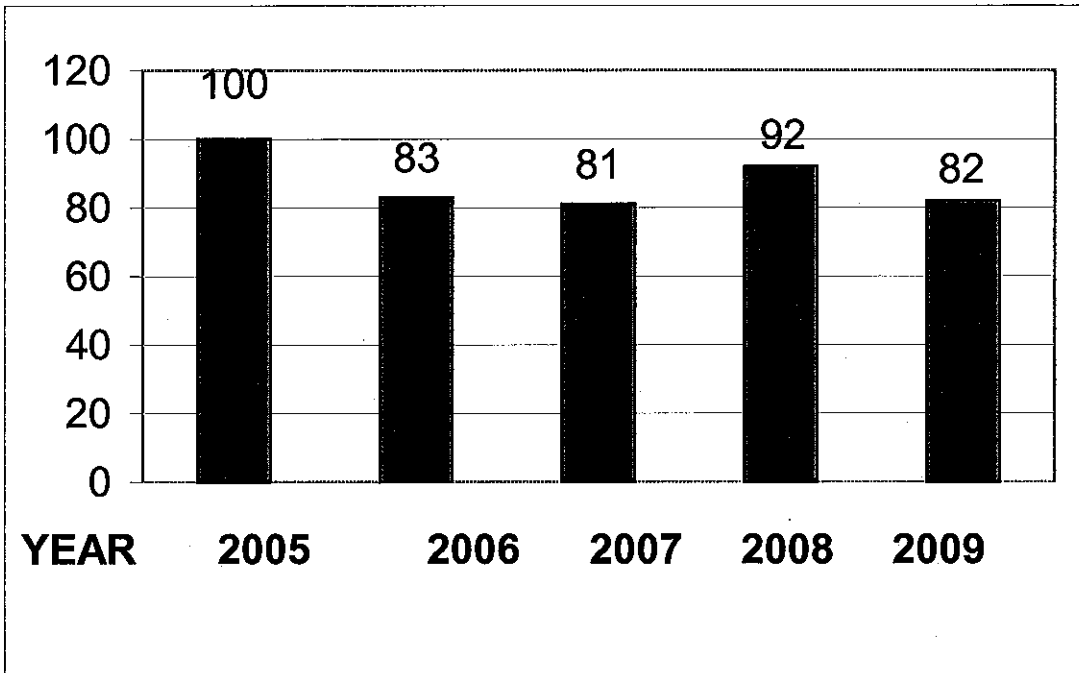
DUI ARRESTS (2005 - 2009)



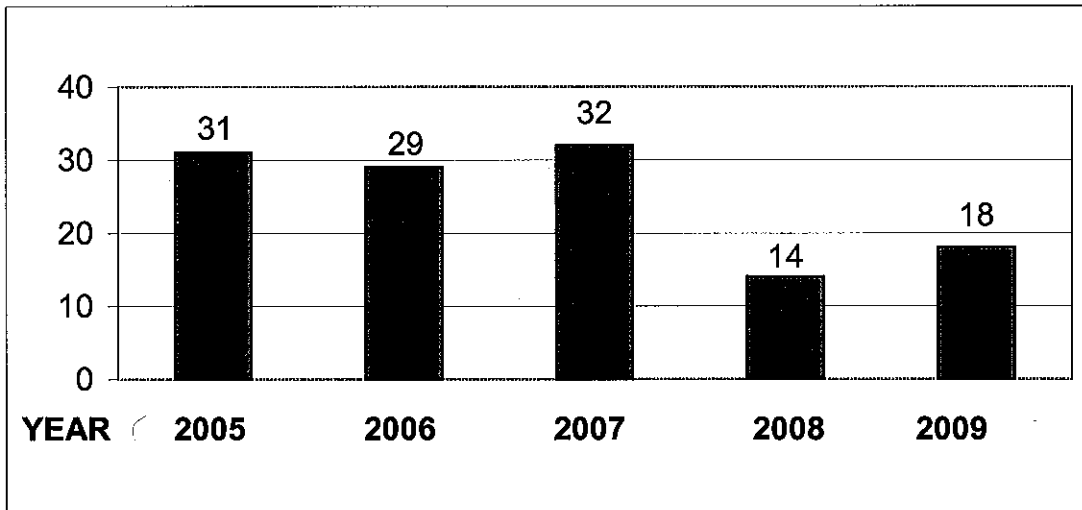
ACCIDENTS CAUSED BY DUI (2005 - 2009)



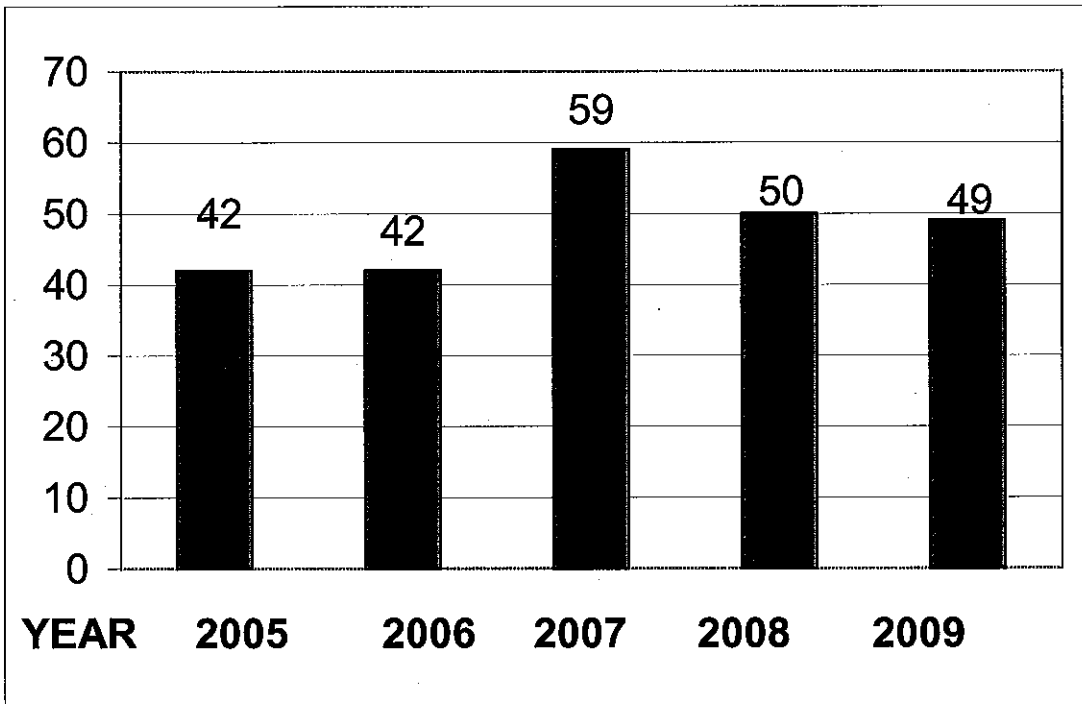
DOMESTIC DISPUTES (2005 - 2009)



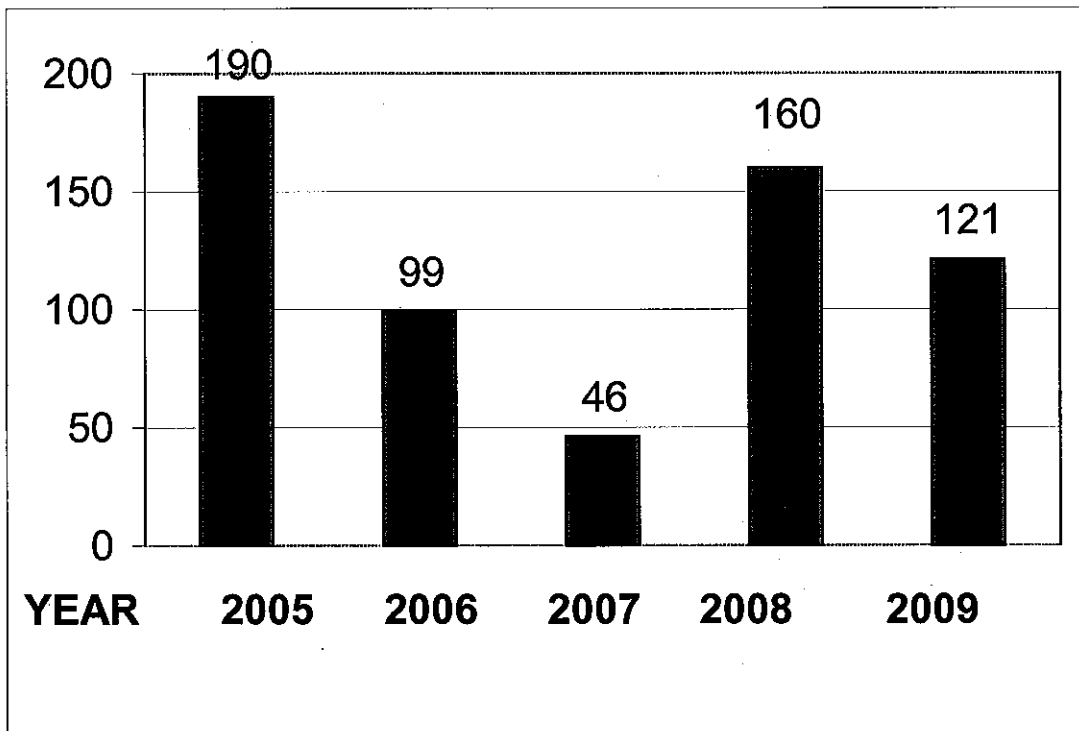

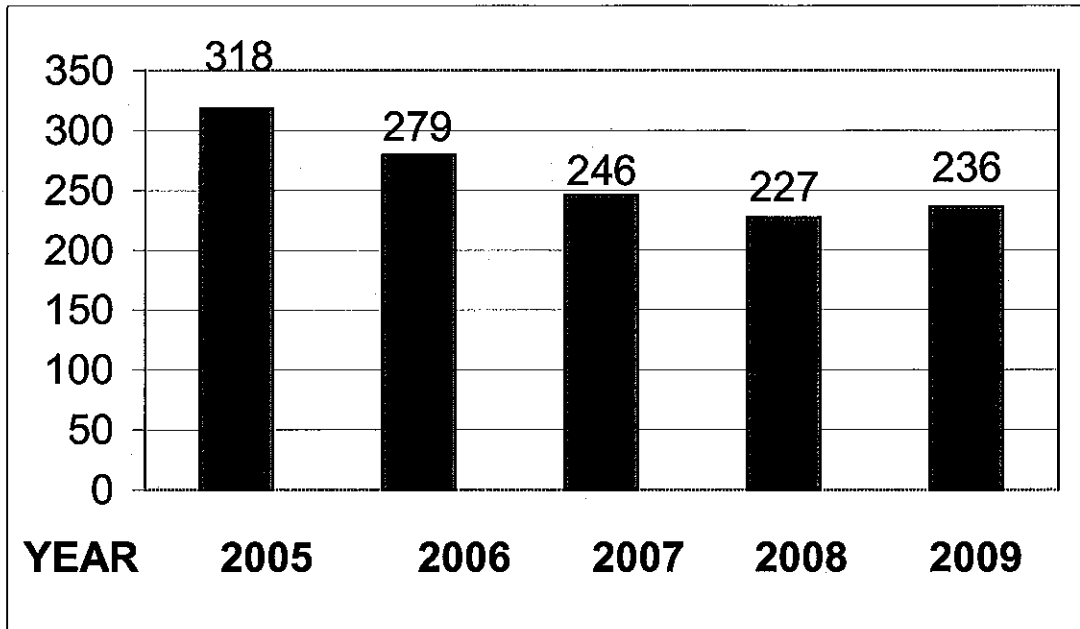

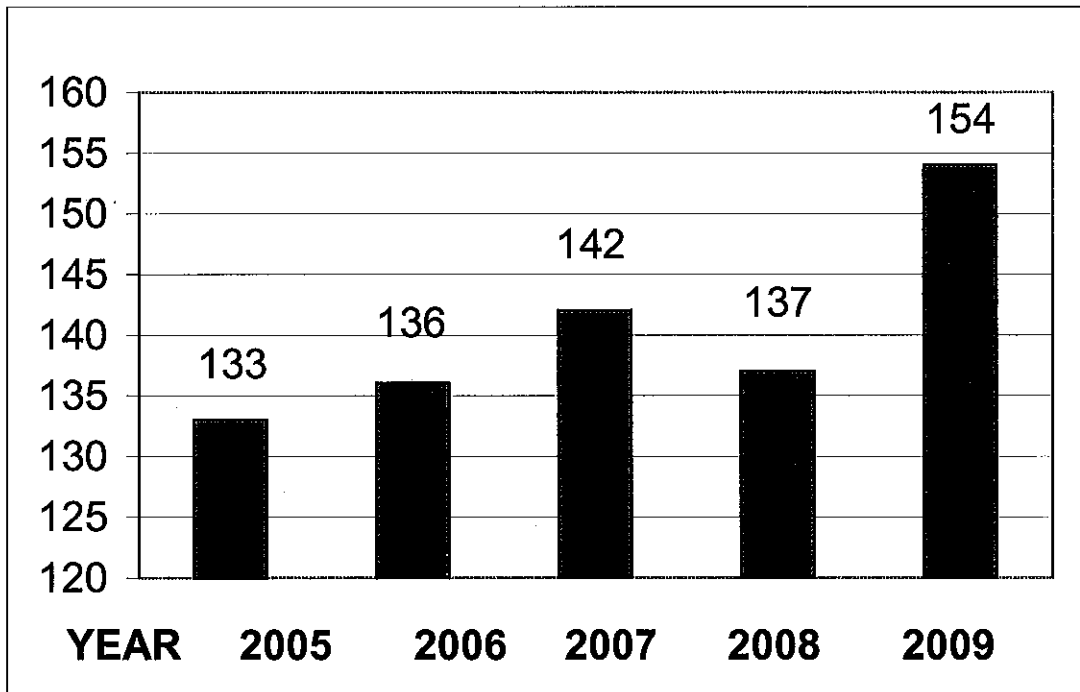

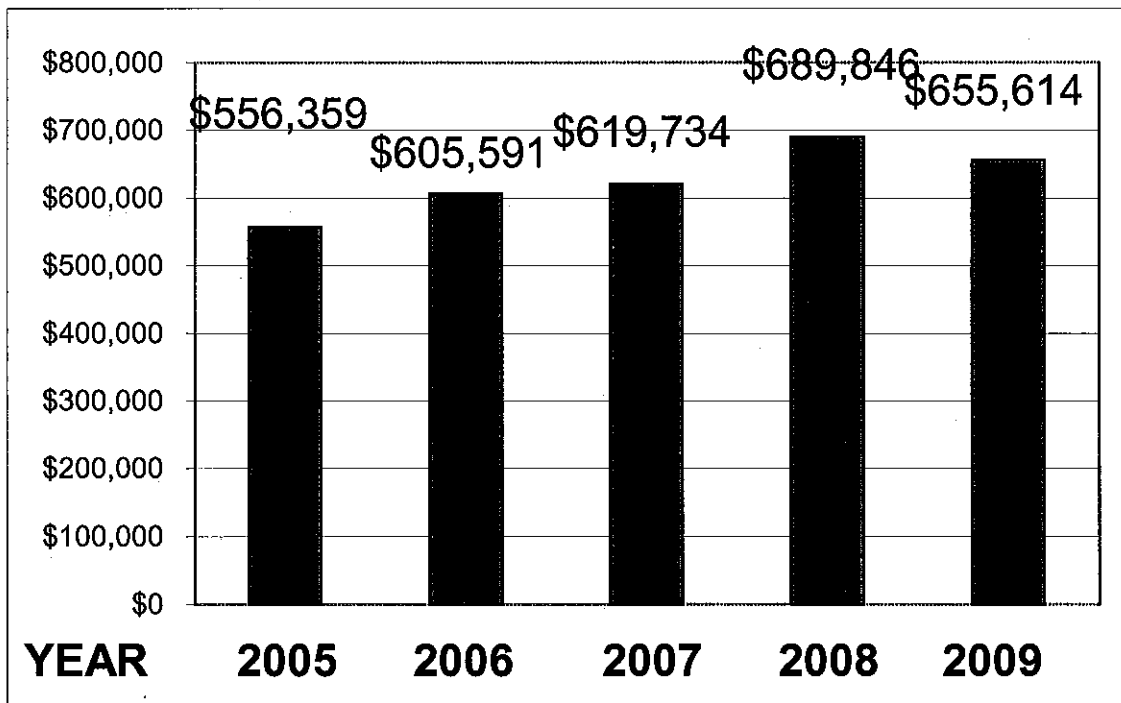
TOTAL MANHOURS FOR CERTAIN ACTIVITIES 2009



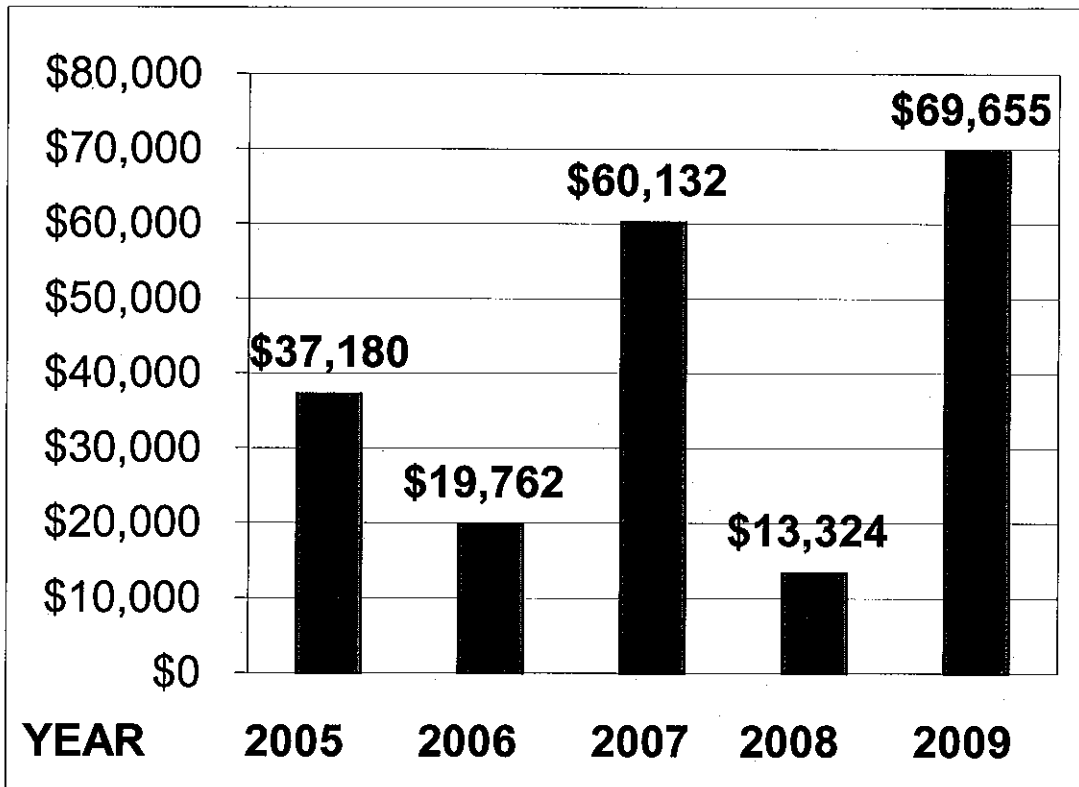
MONIES BUDGETED (2005 - 2009)

ANNUAL REPORT SUMMARY

The Annual Report reflects the various activities of the Police Department for the year of 2009. The report includes police department personnel assignments and duties, as well as a variety of charts and graphs that provide a comparative analysis of the department activities during the past five (5) years.

Our report reflects that Part I crimes in 2009 have increased 13.18% from the year 2008. Increases were noted in Burglary, Theft and Assaults. There were no significant decreases in Part I Crimes.

Part II crimes in 2009 have decreased 14.61% over the year 2008. Increases were noted in Criminal Mischief, Sex Offenses, Drug Abuse, D.U.I. and Public Drunkenness. Decreases were noted in Other Assaults, Forgery, Fraud, Embezzlement, Weapons Offenses, Offenses Against Children & Families, Liquor Laws, Disorderly Conduct and All Other Offenses.

The overall crimes for 2009 in the Borough have decreased 7.22% from 2008.

There has been a decrease in 2009 in Criminal Arrests for Adults of 1.75% since the year 2008. Juvenile Allegations for the same time have decreased by 48.98%.

Non-Traffic citations that were issued in 2009 decreased 24.43% compared to the year 2008. Traffic citations for the same time decreased by 11.96%.

Total Parking Tickets issued in 2009 decreased 23.6% compared to the year 2008. Written warnings decreased by 67.20% during 2009.

The number of traffic accidents that were investigated in the borough increased 12.4% since the year 2008. Accident injuries increased 11.47%. Thirty percent (30.23%) of all accidents reported were Careless Driving, which was the main cause for accidents in 2008 and 2009. Most accidents occurred on Wednesday and fifty percent (50.38%) of all accidents occurred between 8:00 A.M. and 4:00 P.M.

As in the past, the Palmyra Borough Police Department continues to provide the Borough with the most professional police service possible, maintaining the high standards our community can be proud of.
