

**Library Board of Directors Report**

**The Palmyra Public Library Board of Directors met on February 20, 2017**

**Library Production Figures:** Circulation for January 2018 12,178, down 498 or -3.93% compared to January 2017. Patron traffic for January 2018 was 11,871 compared to 11,632 in January 2017.

**Budget/Treasurer's Report:** At the end of January 2018, total YTD income was \$30,761.00. YTD expenses were \$17,919.67.

**Lebanon County Library System:** The board voted on a new formula for county funding, but the Executive Directors of the county libraries are tasked with determining a new "use" formula.

**EITC:** Nothing new.

**Grants:** The library has applied for a \$1000 Walmart grant for summer learning.

**Fund Raising Events:** Preparations are being made for Springtime in the Vineyard held Sat, April 14 at Hershey Vineyards. Tickets may be purchased at the library or from any board member.

**Long Range Planning:** The steering committee will be looking into refinancing the library's mortgages.

**Misc.:** The library has been awarded the Silver Star in basic literacy & will be working on the same for financial literacy.
