

Library Board of Directors Report
Presented by Jane Quairolì for presentation at the
July 28, 2015 Council Meeting

- **The Palmyra Public Library Board of Directors met on July 21 2015**
- **Library Production Figures: Circulation for June 2015-17,119, up 526 or +3.17% compared to June 2014. Patron traffic for June 2015 was 17,335 compared to 16,163 in June 2014.**
- **Fund Raising Events:** The library's end of summer celebration, "Every Hero has a Party", is scheduled for Saturday, August 15 from 9am-1pm. The discount coupons for the Flagship Cinema in Palmyra will be available thru July 31st. The Evening at the Vineyard at Hershey raised \$13,000+ for the library. Figures on the book sale are not yet available. There is no news of the library becoming a US Passport office. The library has applied to do a fundraising day at Chiptole in Hershey in May.
- **Long Range Planning:** The Ivy Group is in the midst of the survey. Library board members will be conducting face to face interviews with some prominent members of the community.
- **Library Building:** See Long Range Planning above.
- **Misc:** As of July 21st, the library has not yet received the \$40,000 payment from NLT. It is usually received by the end of June. Due to its high cost, the fundraising software is being put on hold for the time being, but should be included in the 2016 budget.
