

Library Board of Directors Report

The Palmyra Public Library Board of Directors met on December 19, 2017

Library Production Figures: Circulation for November 2017 was 11,491, down 488 or -4.07% compared to November 2016. Patron traffic for November 2017 was 10,087 compared to 11,398 in October 2016.

Budget/Treasurer's Report: At the end of November 2017, total YTD income was \$277,532.26. YTD expenses were \$303,591.95.

Lebanon County Library System: The board is still looking into the proposed change to the county's funding system.

EITC: 1st Citizens Community Bank presented PPL with a check for \$5000.

Grants: PPL has received a \$1000 from 1st Energy for STEM

Fund Raising Events: Annual fund drive has brought in \$24,145.85 so far. There is a wine & chocolate tasting being held February 8 at the library.

Long Range Planning: The board has decided not to follow thru with phase 2 of the Schultz & Williams plan. The board will proceed on its own & with the help of Don Papson & Productive Fundraising.
