The Palmyra Public Library Board of Directors met on July 18, 2017

Library Production Figures: Circulation for June 2017 was 16,197, down 928 or -5.42% compared to June 2016. Patron traffic for June 2017 was 15,826 compared to 16,507 in June 2016.

Budget/Treasurer's Report: At the end of June 2017, the total YTD income was \$49,140.99. YTD expenses were \$39,379.94.

Steering Committee: Will be meeting July 19, 2017 to discuss goals for fundraising.

Palmyra School District: Taxes will be going up next year. Looking at updating Forge Elementary. Middle School renos seem to be on schedule.

Lebanon County Library System: Nothing to report. Next meeting is in September.

Grants: Still waiting for a response from Rotary for a Waggin' Tales grant, Kiwanis grant for Little Explorers & the Foundation for Enhancing Communities Greater Harrisburg Foundation Early Childhood Strategic Initiative Phase 2 Grant.

Fund Raising Events: The book sales raised \$9,792.75.

Long Range Planning: The board approved to move ahead with the wealth screening process of the feasibility study. Donor Perfect (software program) implementation meeting will be July 27th.
