

Library Board of Directors Report

The Palmyra Public Library Board of Directors met on March 20, 2017

Library Production Figures: Circulation for February 2018 11,234, down 382 or -3.31% compared to February 2017. Patron traffic for February 2018 was 12,451 compared to 11,524 in February 2017.

Budget/Treasurer's Report: At the end of February 2018, total YTD income was \$69,844.92. YTD expenses were \$19,959.10.

Lebanon County Library System: The new funding formula for county will be based on 70% "use" & 30% census. The Executive Directors of the county libraries will be determining a new "use" formula.

EITC: Nothing new.

Grants: Nothing new on the \$1000 Walmart grant for summer learning.

Fund Raising: Preparations are being made for Springtime in the Vineyard held Sat, April 14 at Hershey Vineyards. Tickets may be purchased at the library or from any board member. \$3,730.00 YTD generated in the annual fund drive

Long Range Planning: The steering committee met with Members 1st about refinancing the mortgage & has presented 2 options to the board. A 3rd option might be coming. The pledge form has been designed & naming opportunities have been determined.

Misc.: The library has been awarded their 3rd Silver Star (out of 5) in financial literacy.
