The Palmyra Public Library Board of Directors met on March 19, 2019

Library Production Figures: Circulation for Feb 2019 was 11,899, up 672 or 5.84% compared to Feb 2018. Library visitors was 11,508 compared to 12,451 in Feb 2018.

Budget/Treasurer's Report: At the end of Feb 2019, total YTD income was 93,610.31. YTD expenses were \$41,224.61.

Lebanon County Library System: Nothing new to report.

EITC: Nothing new.

Grants: United Way has invited us to apply for funding. Awaiting news from Community Aid on a grant for funding Waggin' Tales.

Fund Raising:

Springtime in the Vineyard will be held on Sat, April 13 from 7-9:30pm at The Vineyard & Brewery at Hershey. Tickets are \$60 with a buffet dinner and wine & beer selections. Sponsors & auction donors are currently being sought. **The library currently has \$6,600** in sponsors & \$3,700 worth of items for the silent auction with more expected for both.
