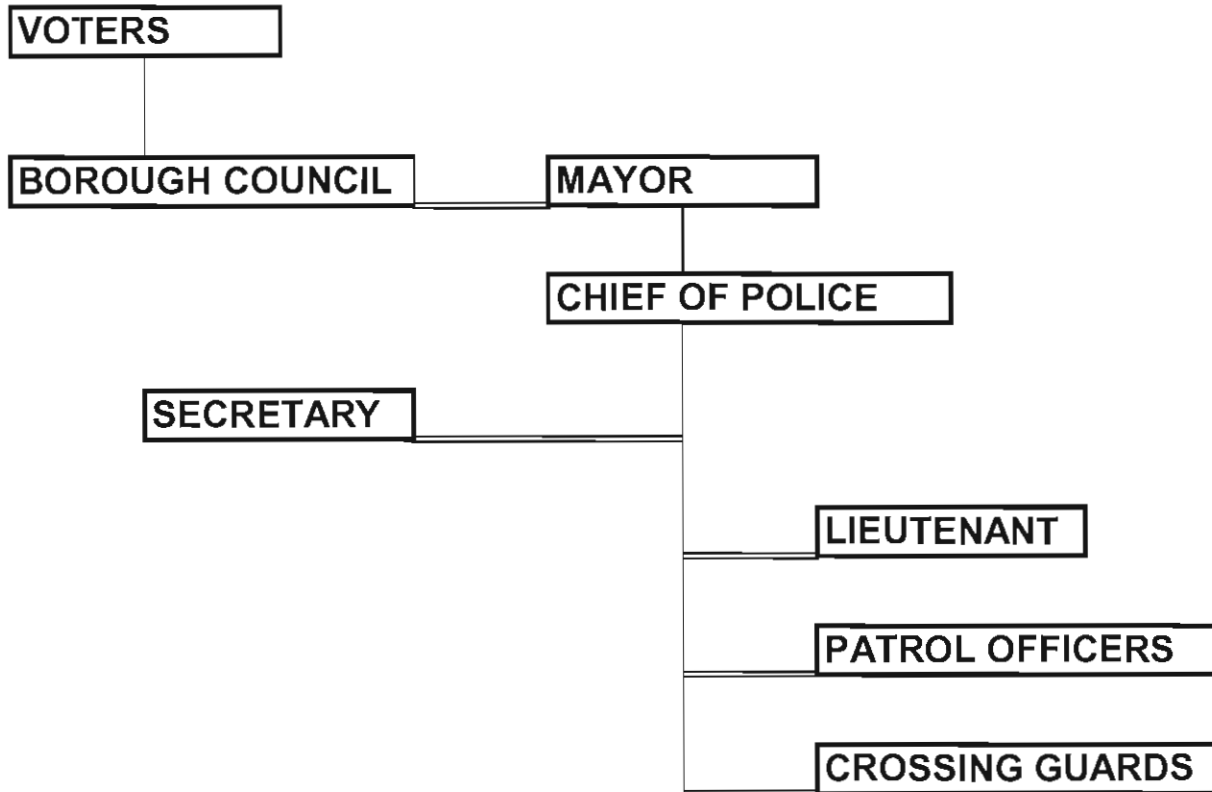

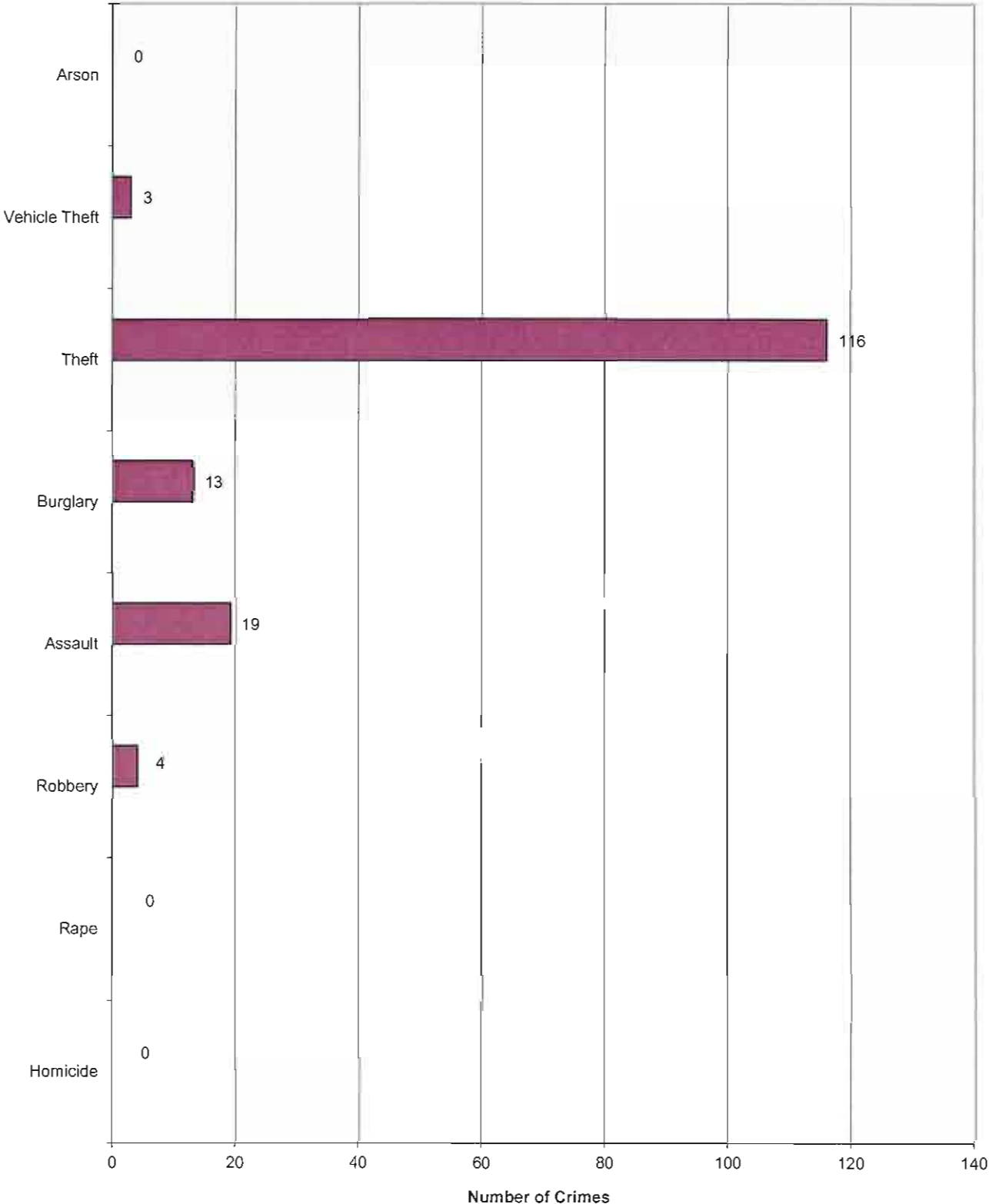

DEFINITIONS

For the purpose of providing a better understanding of the following charts representing the activities of the Police Department, the following definitions are provided:

- PART I OFFENSES** : Criminal Homicide, Forcible Rape, Robbery, Aggravated Assault, Burglary, Larceny-Theft, Motor Vehicle Theft and Arson.
- PART II OFFENSES** : Other Assaults, Forgery and Counterfeiting, Fraud, Embezzlement, Stolen Property (Buying, Receiving, Possessing), Vandalism, Weapons (Carrying, Possessing, etc.), Prostitution and Commercialized Vice, Sex Offenses, Drug Abuse Violations, Gambling, Offenses Against the Family and Children, Driving Under the Influence, Liquor Laws, Public Drunkenness, Disorderly Conduct, and All Other Criminal Offenses.
- POLICE SERVICES** : Represents those activities other than crime, which require investigation or Police Assistance. Police services are generally considered to consist of the following: Fire Calls, Service to Another Agency, Public Service (those calls that render a service, i.e. open doors/windows, lockouts, Message Delivery, etc.), False Alarms, Lost -Found Property, Suspicious Persons, Suspicious Vehicles, Domestic Disputes, Neighborhood Disturbances, Animal Complaints, Mental Cases, Suicides and Attempted Suicides, Suspicious Deaths, Traffic related (funeral escorts, parades, etc.), Surveillance, and other investigations of a non-criminal nature.
- TRAFFIC ACCIDENT INVESTIGATION** : The complete investigation of all motor vehicle accidents which occur within the Borough Limits of Palmyra.

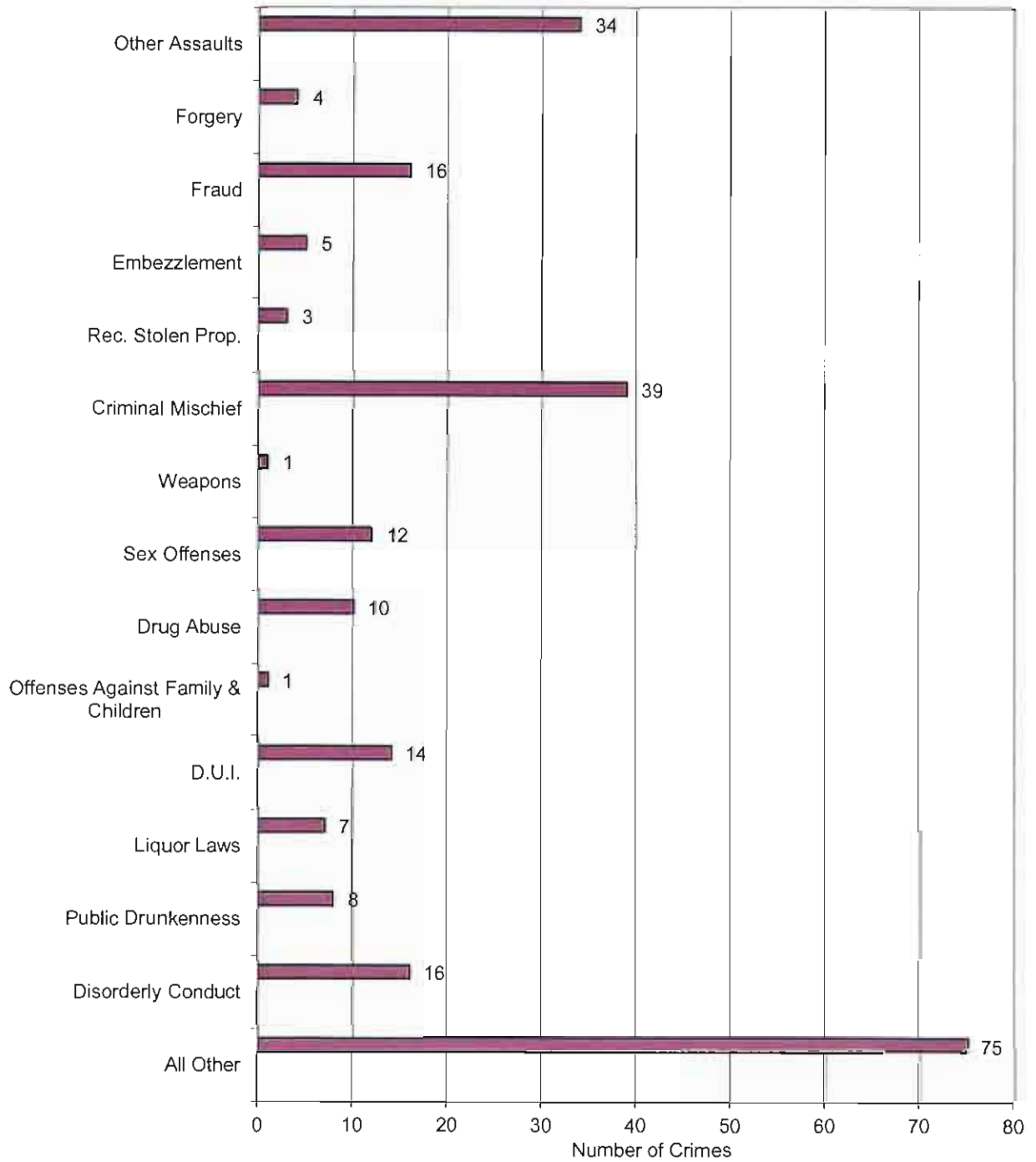

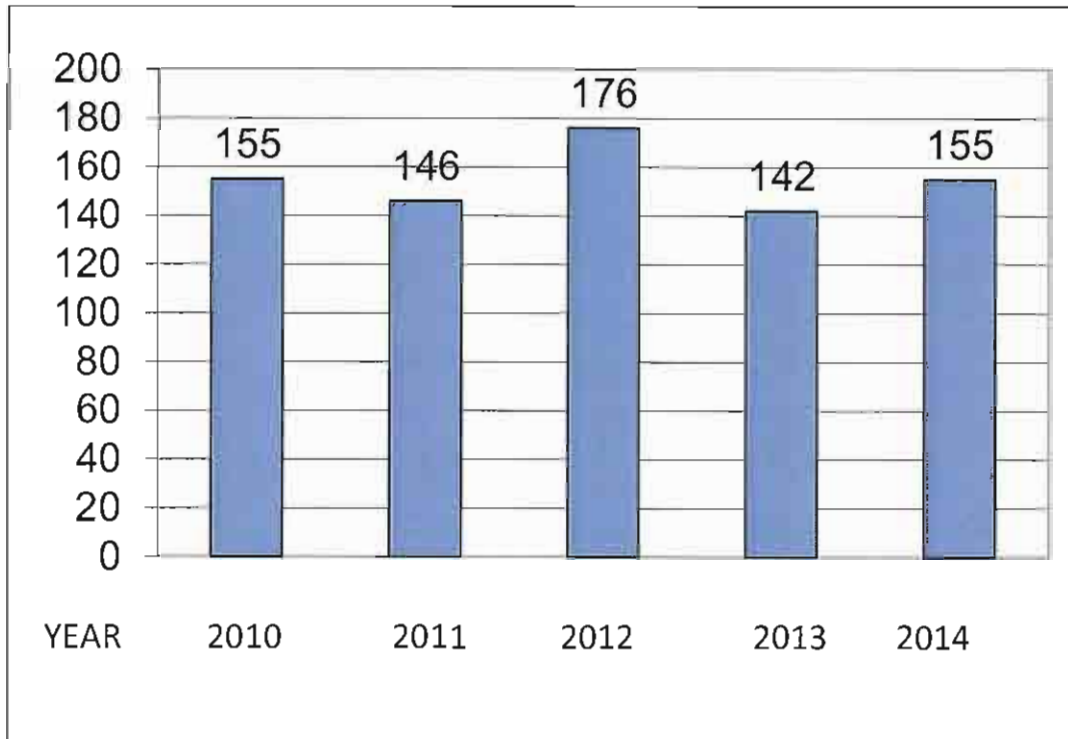

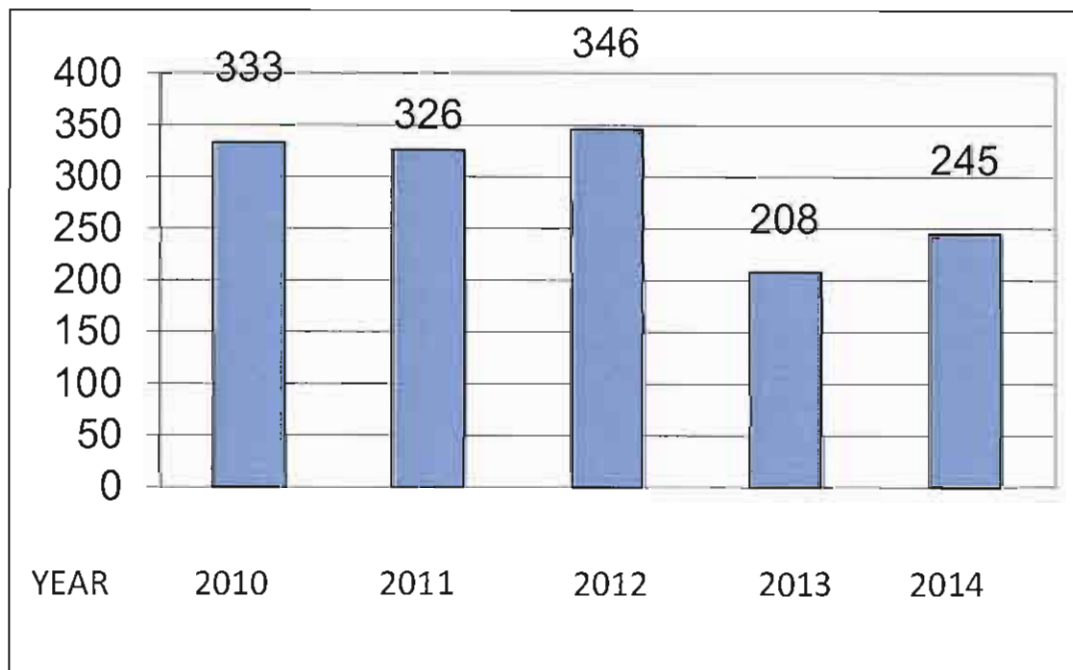

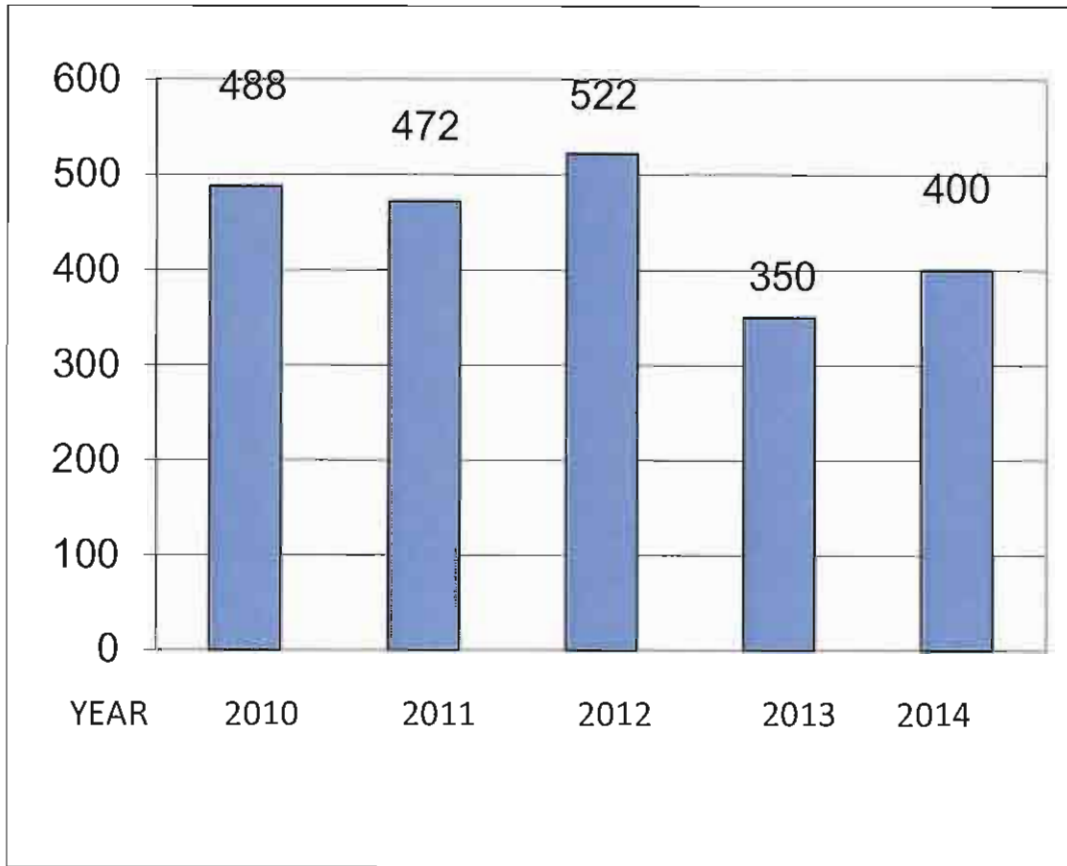
PART I CRIMES (2010 - 2014)



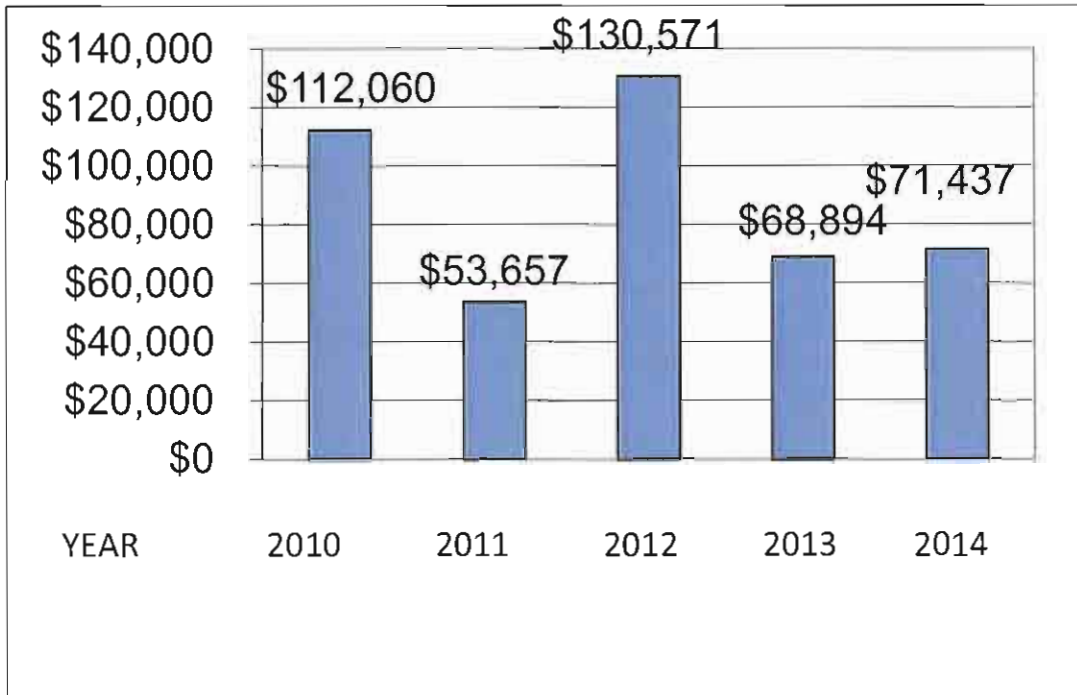

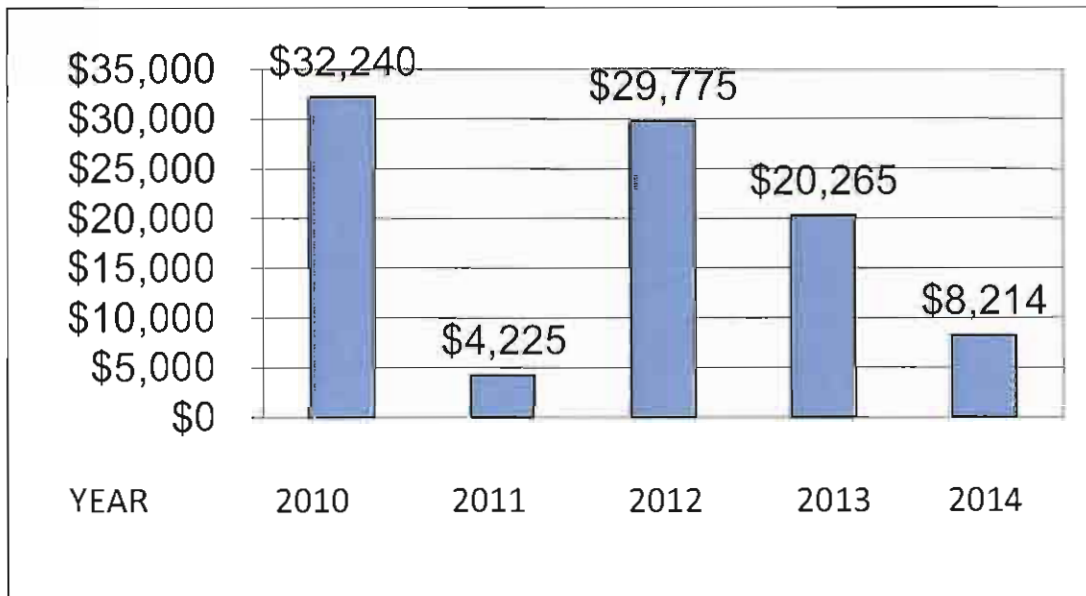
TOTAL CRIMES (2010 - 2014)



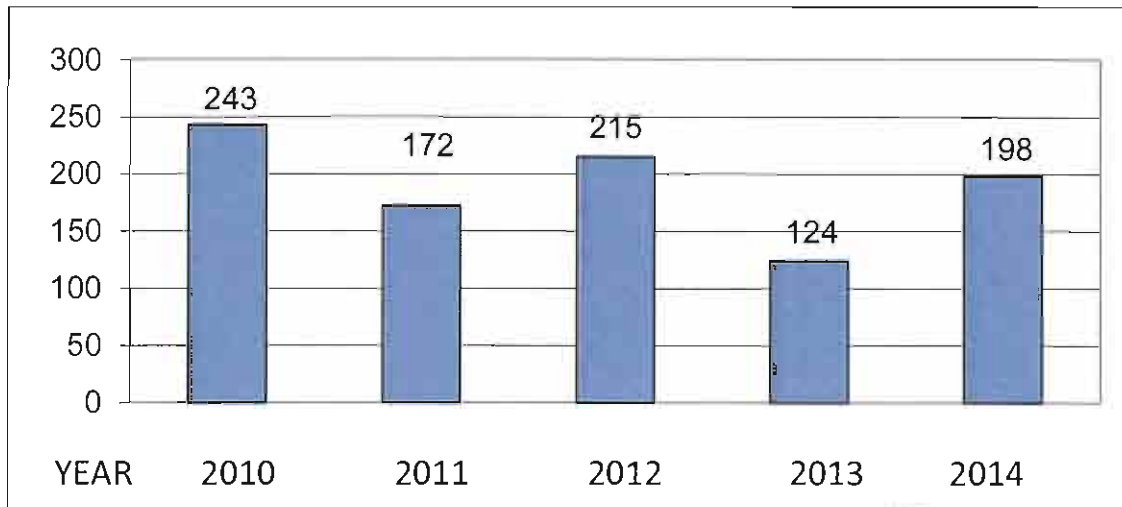
VALUE OF PROPERTY STOLEN (2010 - 2014)



VALUE OF PROPERTY RECOVERED (2010 - 2014)

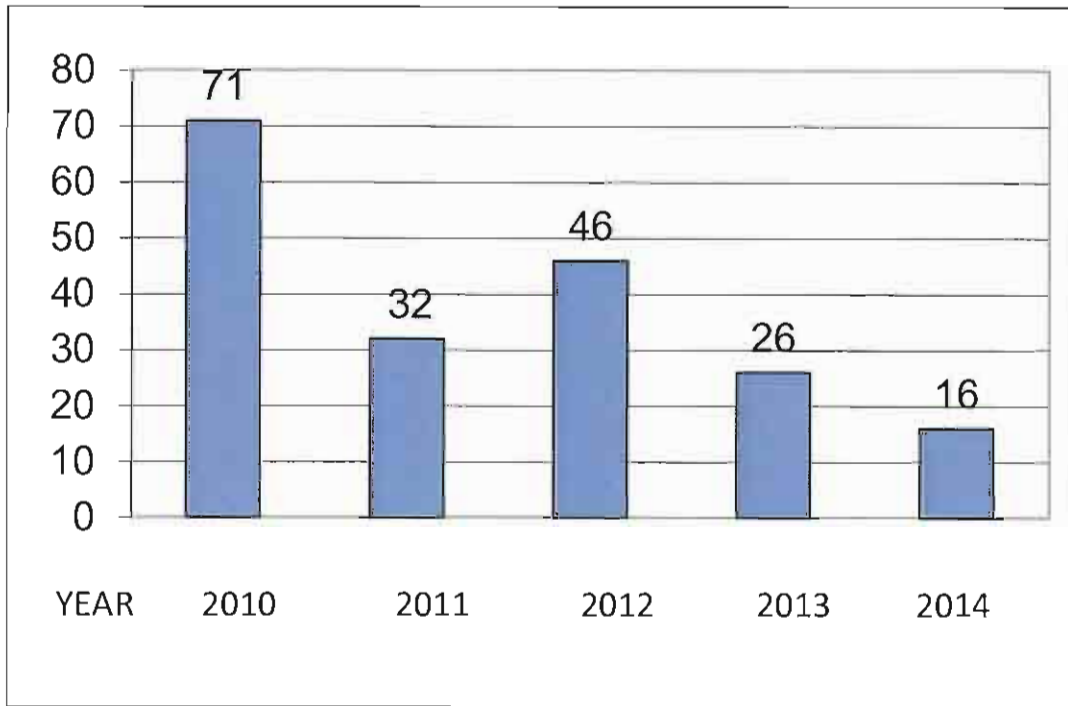

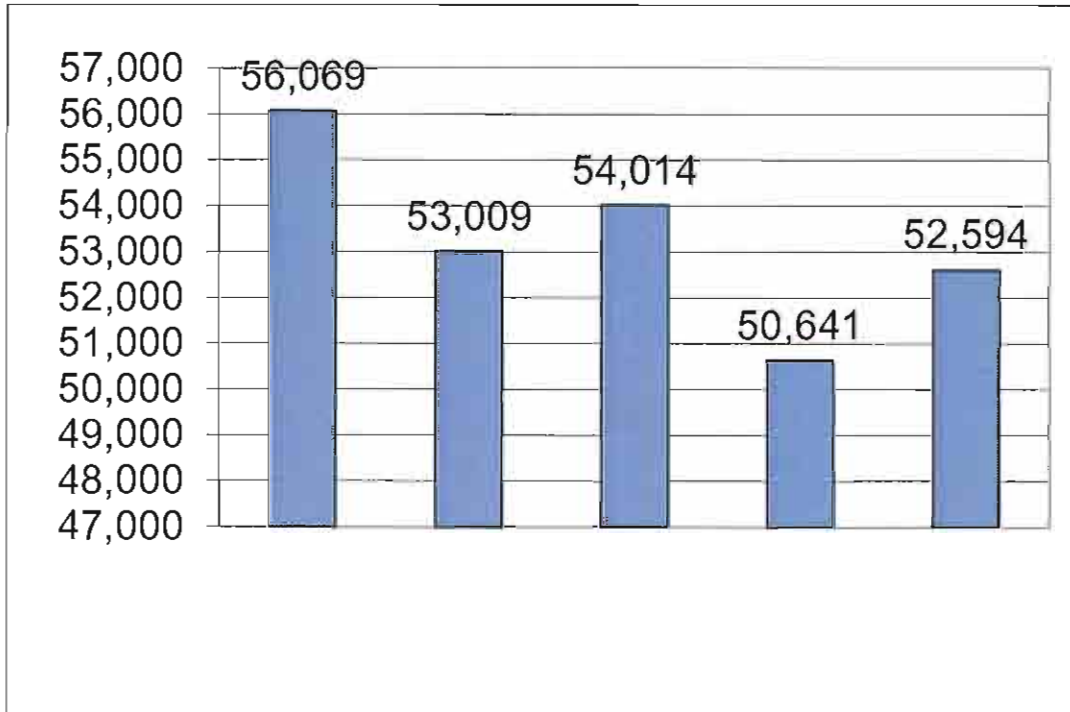

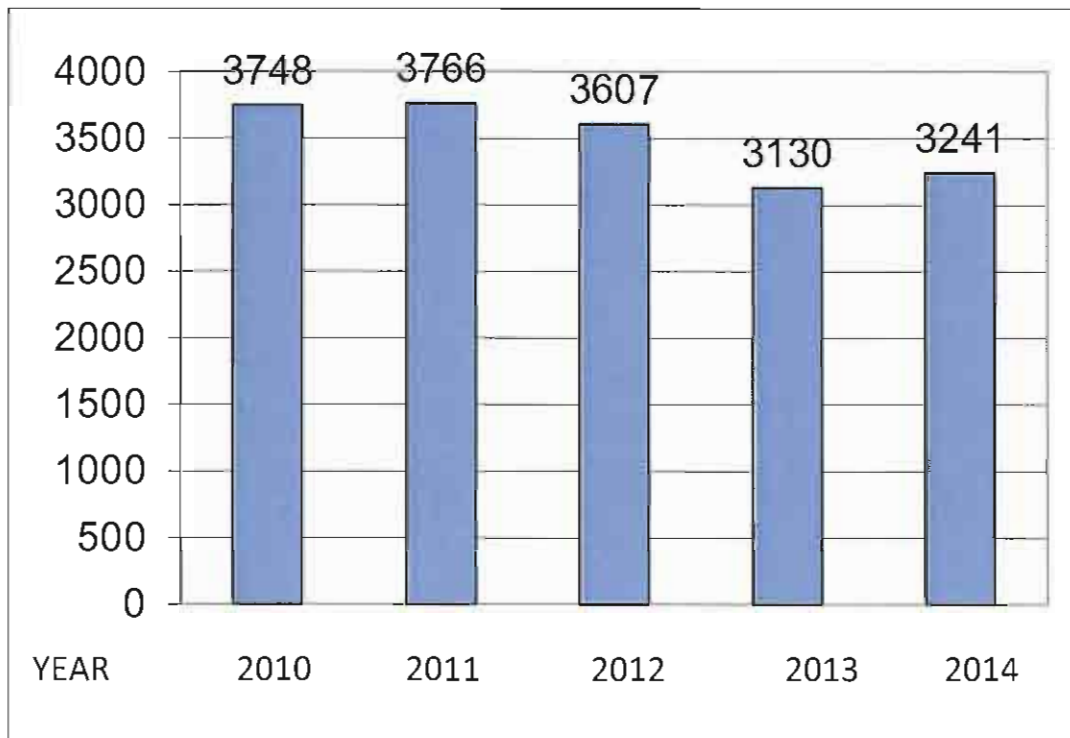
WRITTEN WARNINGS (2010 - 2014)

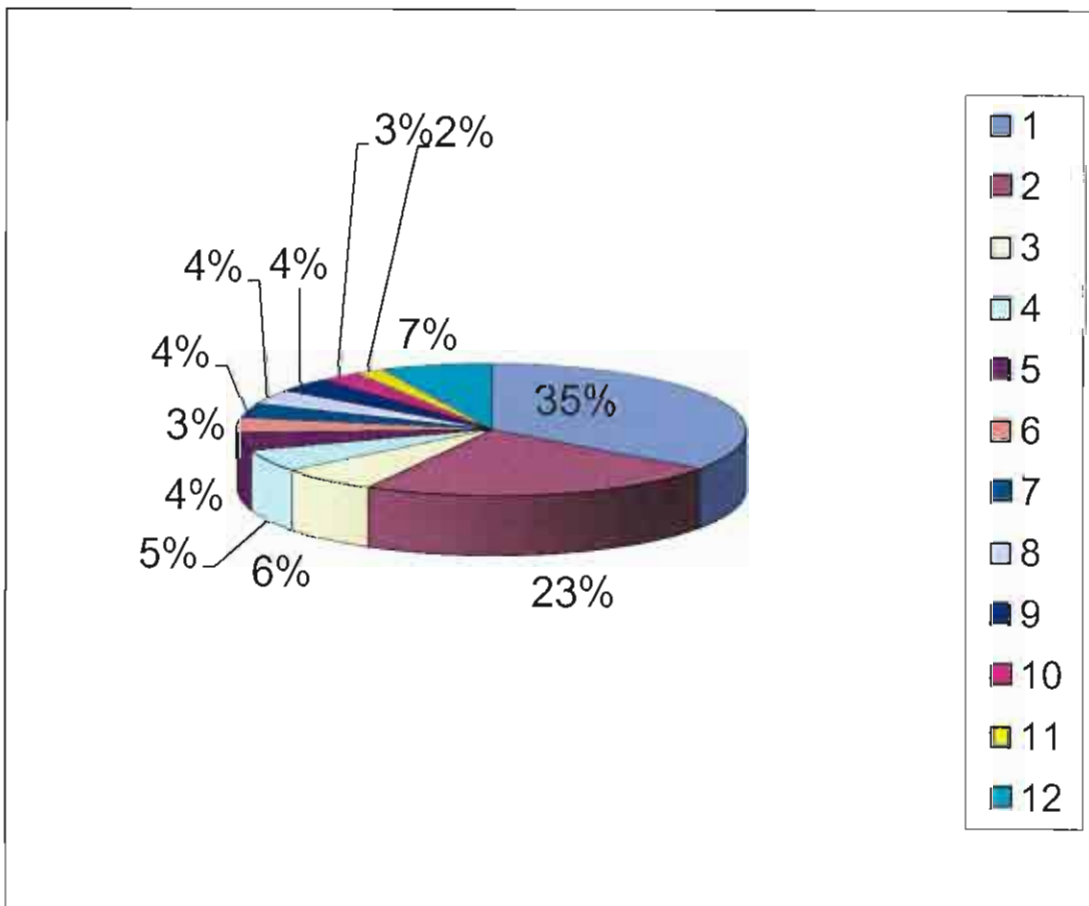


ACCIDENT INJURIES (2010 - 2014)



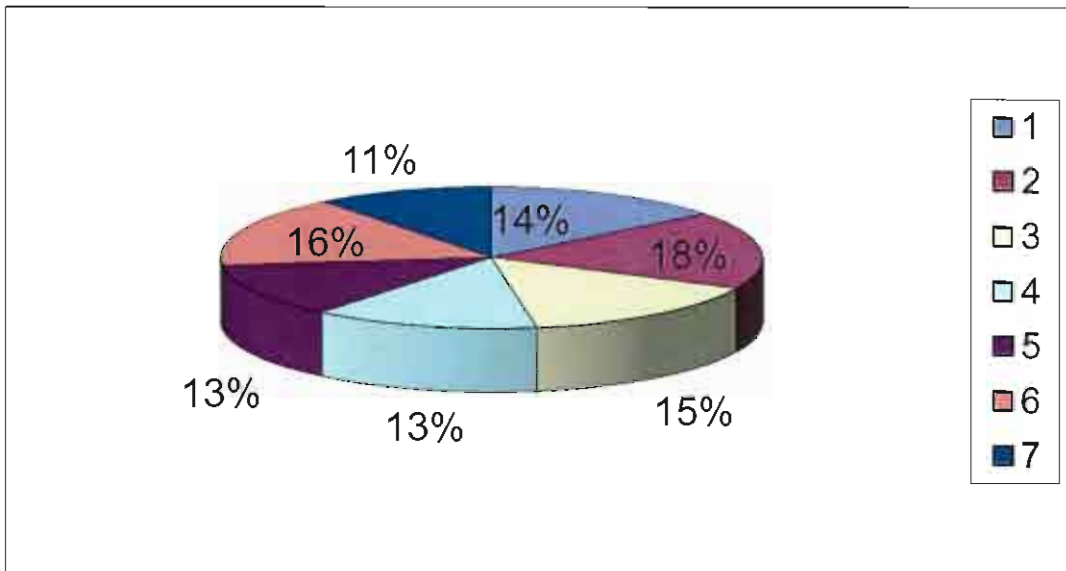

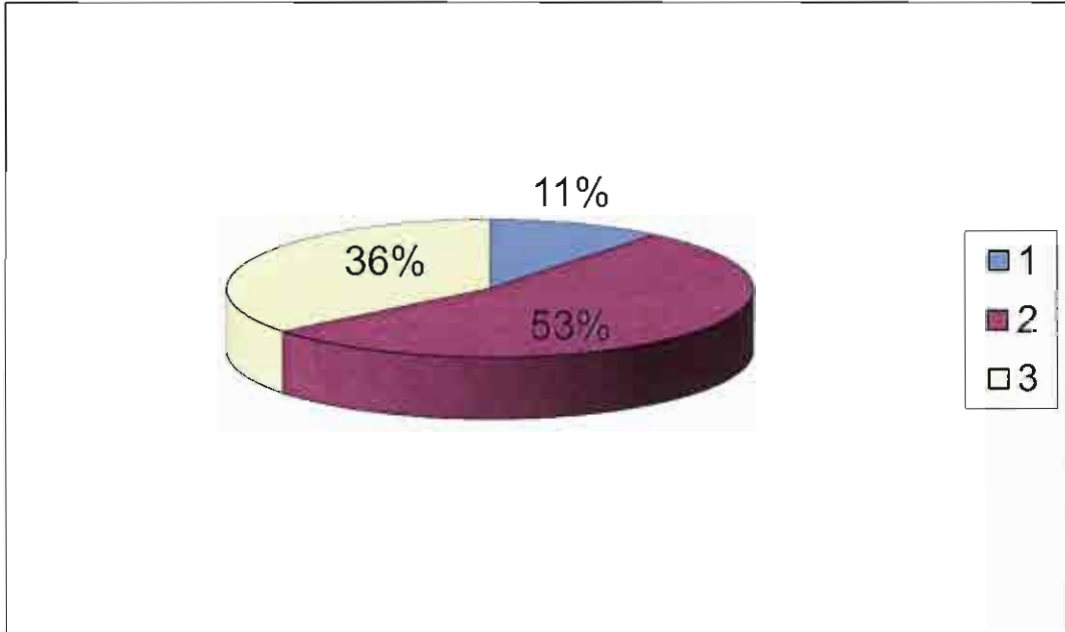

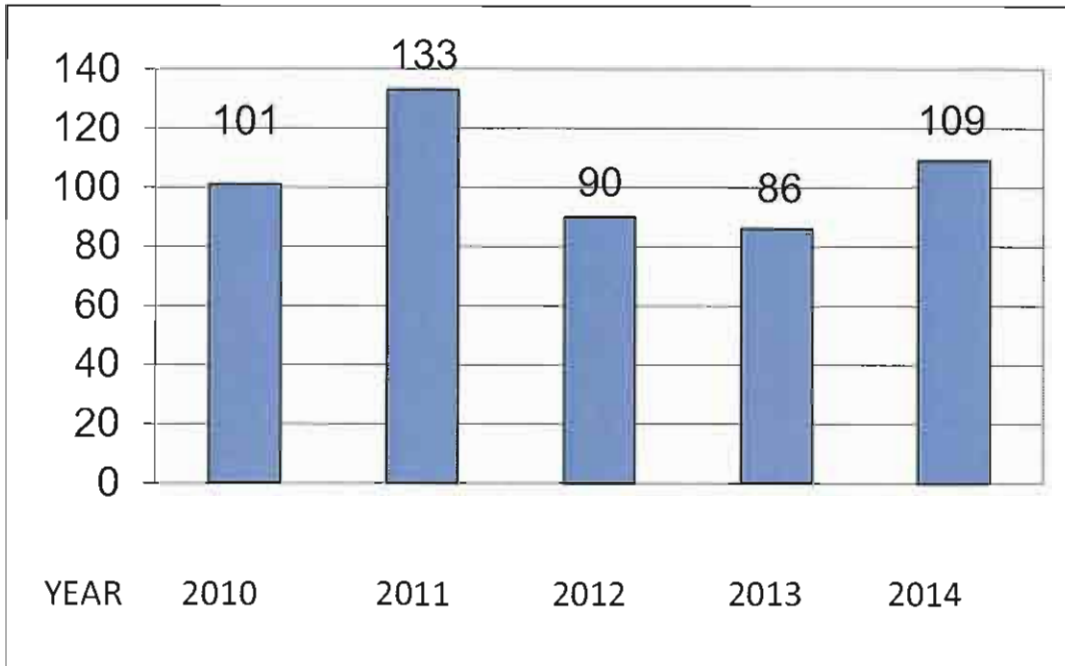
DUI ARRESTS (2010 - 2014)



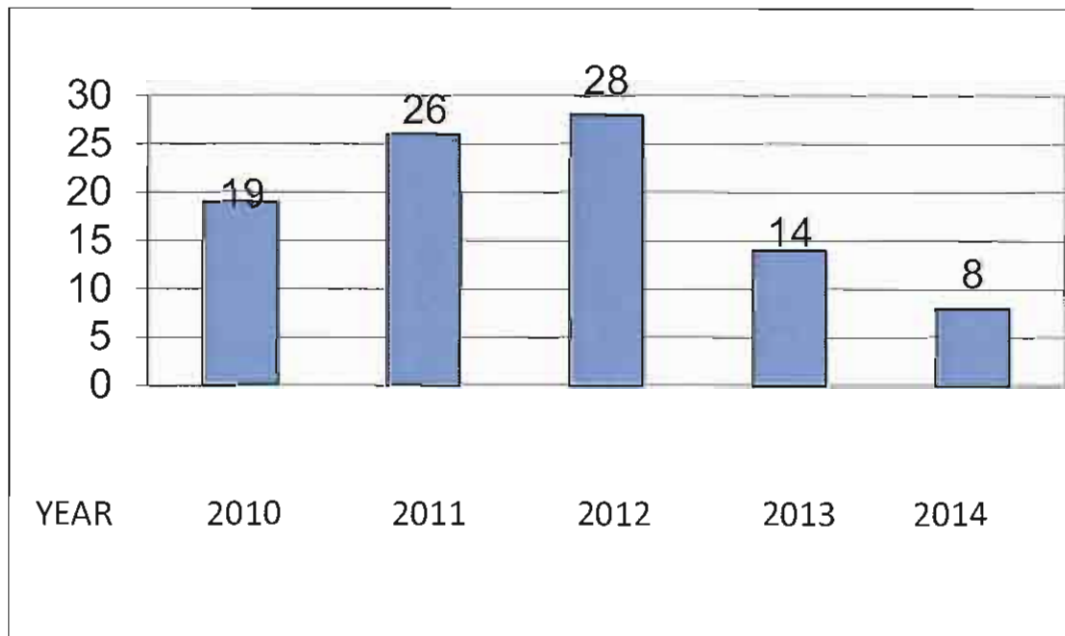
ACCIDENTS CAUSED BY DUI (2010 - 2014)



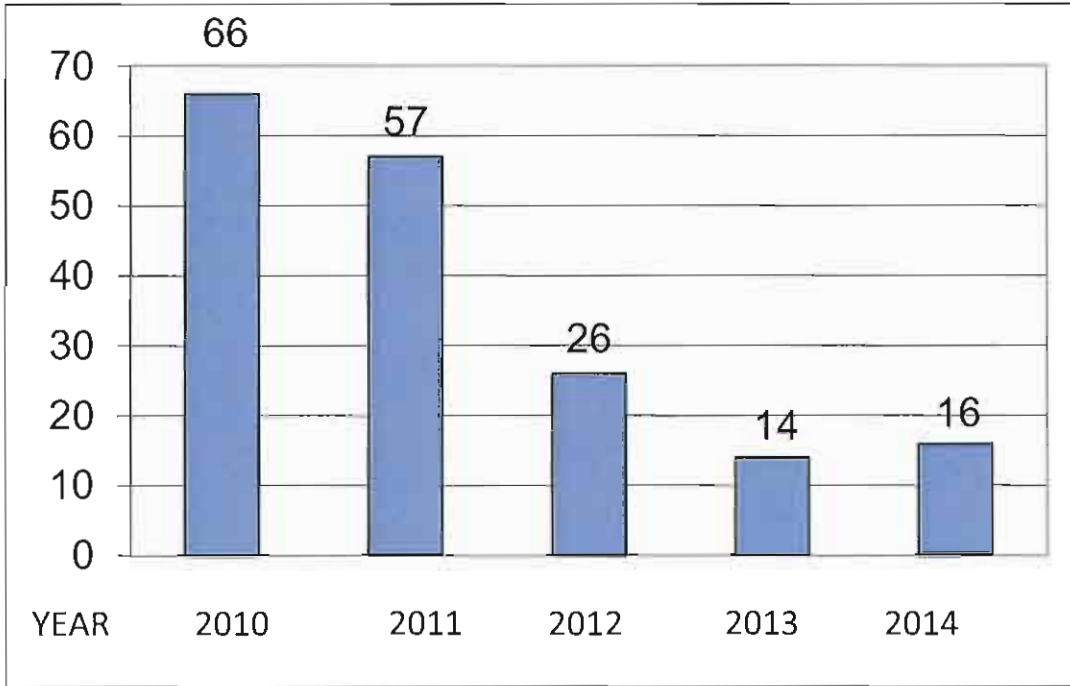
DOMESTIC DISPUTES (2010 - 2014)



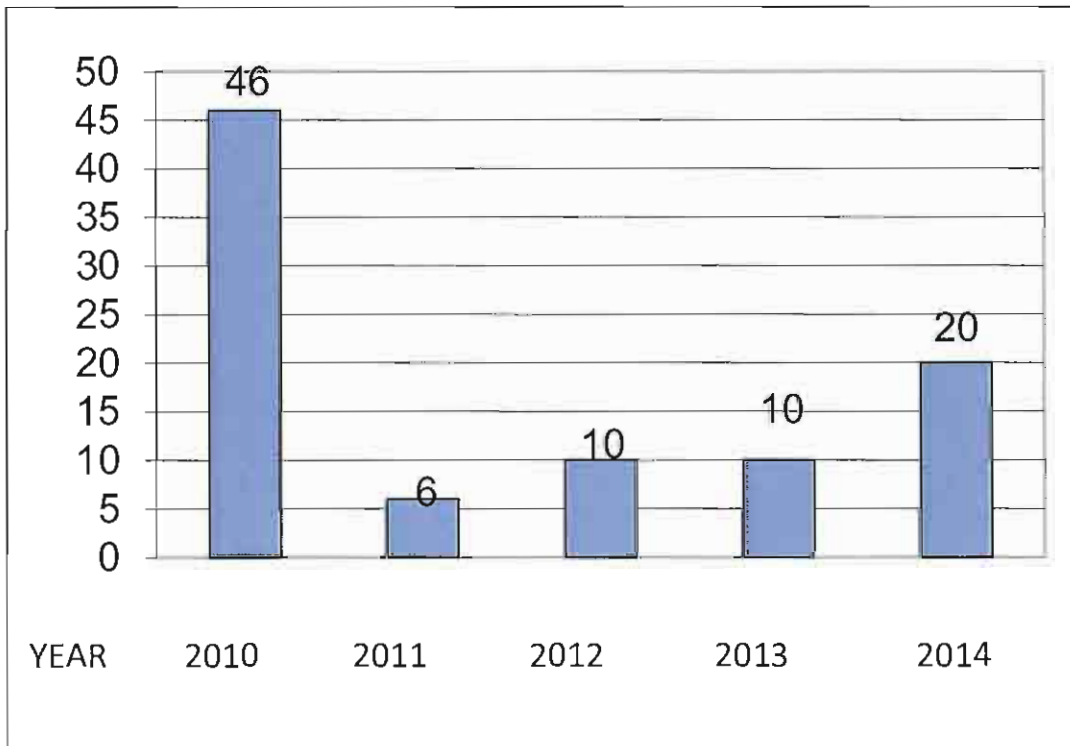

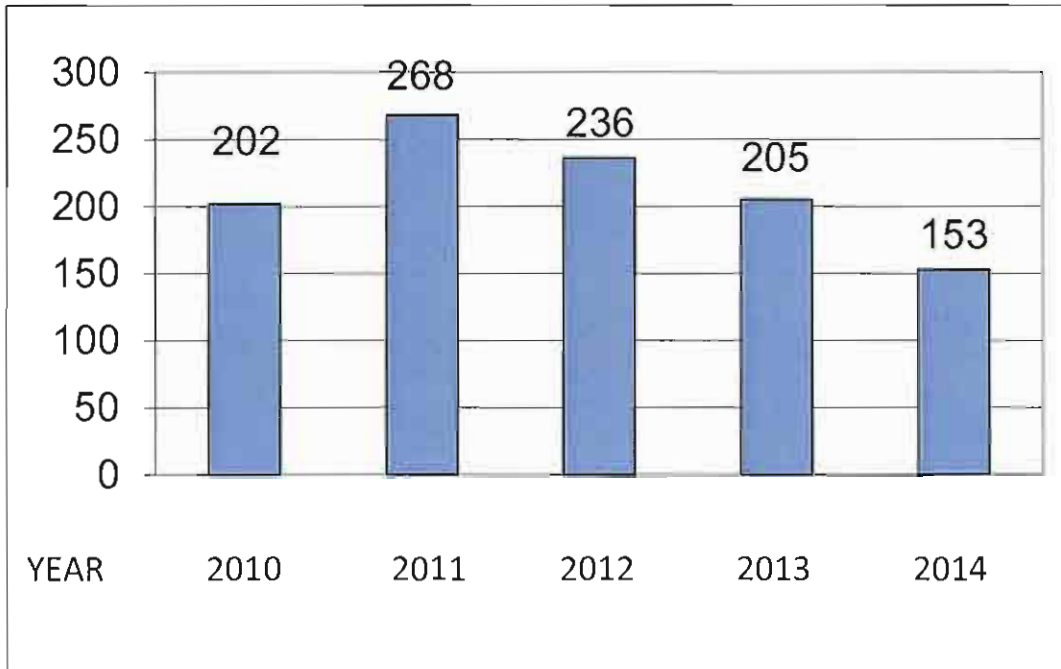

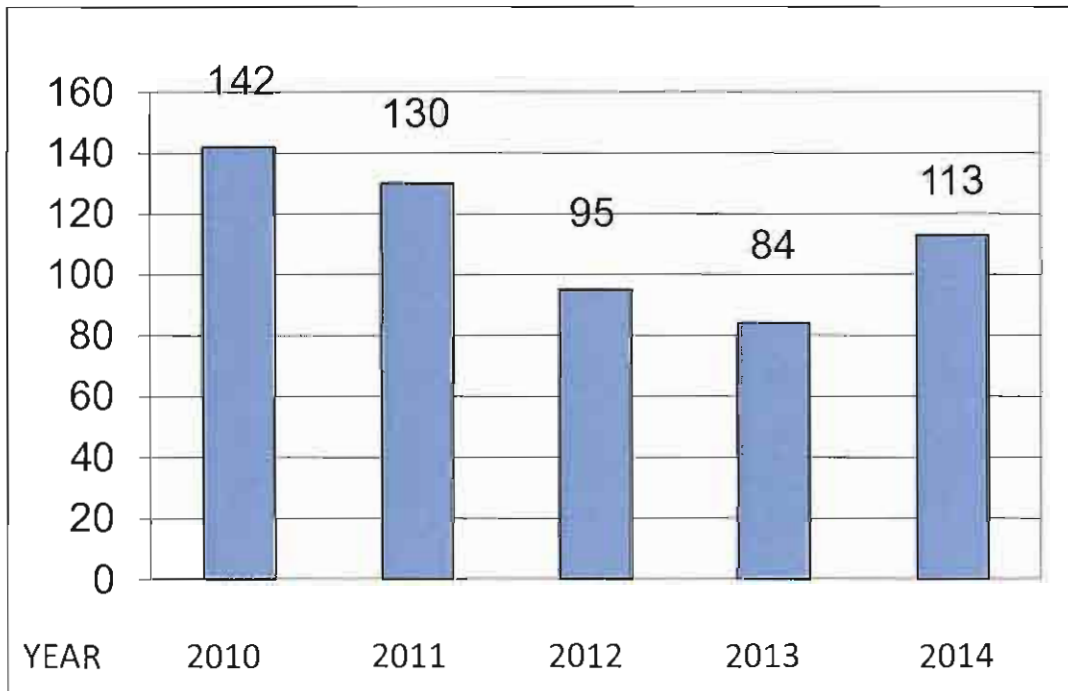

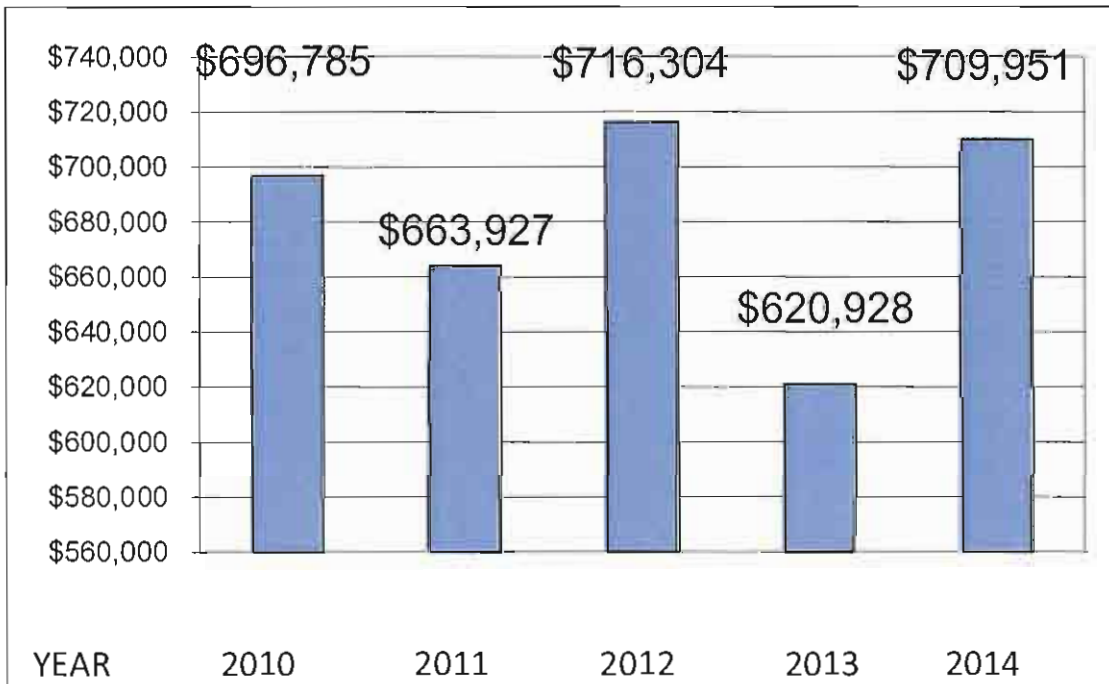
TOTAL MANHOURS FOR CERTAIN ACTIVITIES 2014



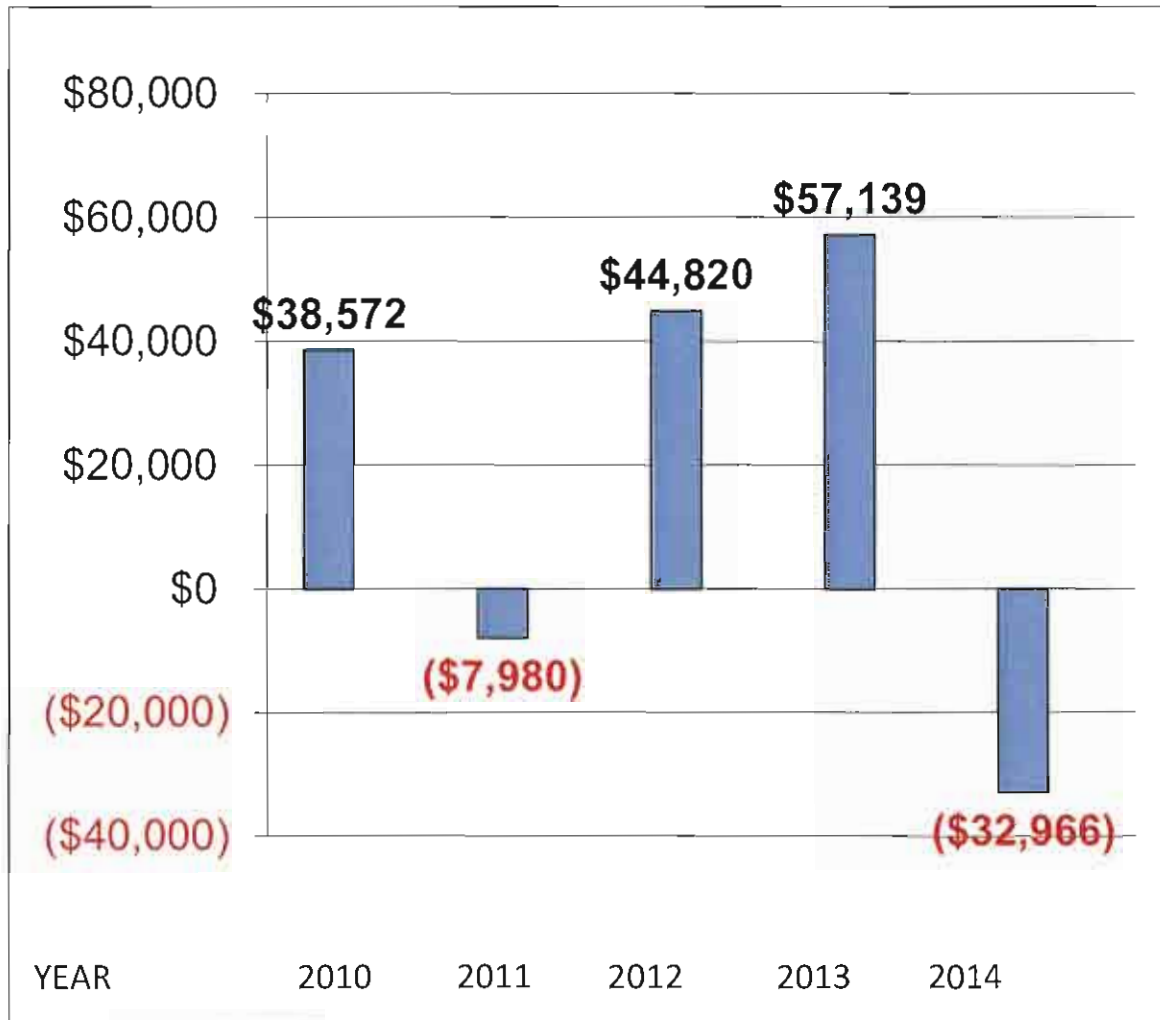
MONIES BUDGETED (2010 - 2014)

ANNUAL REPORT SUMMARY

The Annual Report reflects the various activities of the Police Department for the year of 2014. The report includes police department personnel assignments and duties, as well as a variety of charts and graphs that provide a comparative analysis of the department activities during the past five (5) years.

Our report reflects that Part I crimes in 2014 have increased 9.15% from the year 2013. Increase was noted in Robbery Assault and Theft. Decreases were noted in Burglary in Part I Crimes.

Part II crimes in 2014 have increased 17.70% over the year 2013. Increases were noted in Forgery, Receiving Stolen Property, Sex Offenses, Drug Abuse, D.U.I., Liquor Laws, Public Drunkenness and All Other Offenses. Decreases were noted in Other Assaults, Fraud, Criminal Mischief, Weapons Offenses, Offenses Against Families/Children, and Disorderly Conduct.

The overall crimes for 2014 in the Borough have increased 14.29% from 2013.

There has been an increase in 2014 in Criminal Arrests for Adults of 59.68% since the year 2013. Juvenile Allegations for the same time have decreased by 38.46%.

Non-Traffic citations that were issued in 2014 increased by 2.99% compared to the year 2013. Traffic citations for the same time increased by 11.71%.

Total Parking Tickets issued in 2014 increased 51.05% compared to the year 2013. Written warnings increased by 107.75% during 2014.

The number of traffic accidents that were investigated in the borough decreased 12.5% since the year 2013. Accident injuries decreased 14.28%. Almost thirty-five percent (34.82%) of all accidents reported were Careless Driving, which was the main cause for accidents in 2010 thru 2014. Most accidents occurred on Monday and fifty-three and one half (53.57%) of all accidents occurred between 8:00 A.M. and 3:59 P.M.

As in the past, the Palmyra Borough Police Department continues to provide the Borough with the most professional police service possible, maintaining the high standards our community can be proud of.
